



**NOTICE TO VOTERS OF DATE AFTER WHICH NO ARGUMENTS FOR OR AGAINST A CITY MEASURE MAY BE SUBMITTED TO THE CITY CLERK**

**NOTICE IS GIVEN** that the General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Palos Verdes Estates on March 7, 2017, at which time there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

<p>“Shall an ordinance be adopted that continues a levy of the existing special tax for a period of twelve (12) years on each eligible parcel in the City at the initial base rate of \$342.34 plus \$0.196073 per square foot of building improvement effective July 1, 2017, and maintains the existing 6.2% limit on annual adjustments, initially generating approximately \$4.7 million annually to finance fire suppression and paramedic services?”</p>	<b>YES</b>

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN**, that Pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the legislative body of the City, or any member or members thereof authorized by the body, or any individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations, may file a written direct argument, not to exceed 300 words in length, accompanied by the printed name(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument, for or against the City measure.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that, based upon the time reasonably necessary to prepare and print the arguments and sample ballots/voter information guide for the election, the City Clerk has fixed, **Tuesday, December 13, 2016**, during normal business hours, as posted, as the date after which no arguments for or against the City measure may be submitted to the City Clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as provided in the Article 4, accompanied by the printed names(s) and signature(s) of the author(s) submitting it, or if submitted on behalf of an organization, the name of the organization, and the printed name and signature of at least one of its principal officers who is the author of the argument. Arguments shall be submitted to the City Clerk at the City Hall of Palos Verdes Estates, California. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk.

**NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that any ordinance, impartial analysis, or direct argument filed under the authority of the Elections Code will be available for public examination in the City Clerk’s Office for not less than 10-calendar days from the deadline for the filing of the arguments and analysis.
