The Issue

What is the status of the FY 2007-08 budget after eight months?

Analysis of Graphs


Currently, total general fund and total operating fund (excludes capital and sewer) revenues are each running 1% lower than expected. While this is a change from recent past years when total revenues reflected a slight increase to expected (2-4%), this performance is still well within our budget targets and no deviations are anticipated at fiscal year-end. We have seen a closer tracking of development fees compared to budget as the fiscal year has progressed. Club concession receipts continue to perform well, but that is a reflection of our conservative projection of Golf Club receipts for first year operation of the renovated clubhouse. Transit sales tax receipts (Proposition A and C) from Los Angeles County are lower than expected and this reflects the overall trend in declining sales tax receipts as consumers curtail spending in light of the slowing economy.


On the expenditure side, total operating expenditures are 3% lower than expected. Most all departments, with exception of Public Works and capital outlay (equipment replacement), are lower than expected with the Police Department running 10% lower due to several staff vacancies that we anticipate will be filled during March (captain and sergeant positions) with other vacancies (patrol and service officers) filled by year-end.


The City's fiscal and budgetary performance through the end of February, as reflected in the attached graphs, does not raise any areas of concern.
