## OVERVIEW

There were fifteen Part I Crimes reported in Palos Verdes Estates this month. The following is a breakdown of crimes by category: seven burglaries; seven larcenies, and one grand theft auto. Of the burglaries, one was from a house under fumigation, two were from garages, one was by force, and three were at unlocked residences. Of the larcenies, two were from unlocked vehicles, two were packages taken after being delivered, one by false pretenses, and one was property taken from a residence. One vehicle was stolen which was left parked, unlocked on the street.

### CALLS FOR SERVICE
