### **OVERVIEW**

During December of 2018, there were eleven Part 1 Crimes. Seven were residential burglaries and four were thefts from vehicles.

The burglaries were all residential dwellings and the residents were away at the time of the incidents. The larcenies were from parked motor vehicles.

Of the burglaries, one occurred within a 2-hour period from when the residents left their home and returned, and the other six occurred during varied periods while homeowners were away. All of the residential burglaries had the same MO of a rear window smash.

An individual was arrest for residential burglary after fleeing the scene of one of these burglaries. Since that time, we have not had any other rear window smash burglaries reported.
