#### **OVERVIEW**

During September of 2019, there were seven Part I Crimes; one was a residential burglary, two were thefts of vehicles, and four were thefts from vehicles.


The burglary occurred while the victim was away from their home. In this case, the suspects gained entry to the residence by kicking in the front door. The suspects specifically targeted the master bedroom closet and removed the victim's property. This was the last reported burglary prior to the arrest of four individuals for suspicion of residential burglary on September 16, 2019. Since these arrests, we have not received any reports of residential burglaries.

Of the vehicle thefts, one occurred while the victim parked and walked away from their running/unlocked vehicle in the 300 block of Paseo Del Mar. The suspect entered the vehicle and attempted to flee the area. The victim contacted PVEPD in regards to the theft and officers arrived on scene and arrested the suspect. The second vehicle theft occurred at the Palos Verdes Country Club. The suspect entered an unattended PVCC maintenance vehicle and attempted to flee the area. The suspect later crashed the vehicle and fled the area on foot where he was later arrested by PVEPD Officers.

Of the larcenies, two were from parked and unsecure vehicles. In these cases, the suspects gained entry into the vehicles through unlocked doors and removed the victims' property. In the third case, the suspects gained entry to the vehicle by using an unknown device to punch the locking mechanism to the vehicle. The suspect entered the vehicle and removed the victim's property. In the fourth case, the suspects attempted to remove the victim's bed cover to their vehicle/truck.
