Velez has held the positions of Reserve Police Officer, Police Officer, Detective, Field Training Officer and Sergeant. In 2004, he attained the rank of Captain and currently serves as the Support Division Captain, which encompasses the Detective Bureau, communications and jail facilities, as well as budget and project management. During his tenure at the department, Captain Velez has continued his education in the areas of public administration and law enforcement. In his spare time, he enjoys vacationing with his wife, exercising and reading.



Best was born and raised in Long Beach.
After graduating high school, he enlisted in the US Marines and served four years on active duty. In 1995, Captain Best began his career in law enforcement with the Palos Verdes Estates Police Department as a

Services Officer (dispatch/jail). In 1996, Captain Best accepted a police officer cadet position with the Department. After graduating from the Orange County Sheriff's Academy as class sergeant, he immediately began to distinguish himself, becoming the Department's first motorcycle officer. Captain Best then rose to the rank of Police Sergeant in 2007 where he worked as a patrol Watch Commander, the Department's Range Master and, most recently, as the Department's Training Sergeant. ## **Ambassador Program**

ur City is very different from most other local cities as we have a variety of atypical rules and processes. Some of these include the Tree Management Policy, Neighborhood Compatibility and the Homes Association's deed restrictions. Although these help protect the quality of life and property values in the City, they often lead to confusion, especially for new residents.

To address this issue, the City is implementing a new outreach program which we have termed as our "Ambassador Program". Staff will contact new homeowners and offer them a visit with our Planning and Public Works Director, either at City Hall or at their home. The Director will review the home's address file with the property owners, explain City rules and processes, and answer any questions the homeowner might have. Typical subjects would be the processes for adding onto a home, methods to remedy view-encroaching vegetation and means to address traffic issues.

# Staying Safe During the Holiday Season

ince the holiday season is upon us, the Police Department's Detective Bureau would like to offer some safety tips so you can survive this hectic time of year without becoming a victim:

- Keep personal belongings, such as a GPS, lap top or purse, out of view. Visible items in a car can create an enticement that thieves often can't resist.
- When you leave your home, remember to close and lock all windows and doors; and, if you have an alarm make sure you set it. Although we have one of the lowest crime rates in the South Bay, don't forget to take the basic precautions to secure your home.

- If you have items delivered to your home, try to be there when they are delivered, or have the items delivered to a trusted neighbor.
- When you are out shopping and enjoying the holiday season, remember to be aware of your surroundings. Park in a well lit area, go with a friend when visiting unfamiliar places and remember to never let your purse or wallet out of your sight.

Lastly, if you are traveling this holiday season, please submit a Vacation Check Request Form. In order to help prevent your home from being burglarized, you may complete and submit a

Plaza at 6:00 p.m. Make sure all your good girls and boys pay him a visit!


# Holiday Tree Pick-Up

## **Rainy Season Resident Preparation**

ow can you be prepared for a wet season as the winter months approach? Follow these guidelines to make sure you are well-equipped during the rainy season:

- Clean all rain gutters, swales and drainage pipes on private property.
- Is your property subject to flooding? How can water be diverted? Obtain sand bags for emergencies. Empty sandbags are available 24/7 in the Police Department lobby with sand available in the parking lot at the west end of Via Tejon. Additionally, filled sandbags are available inexpensively from most home improvement stores.
- Trim your trees, especially if they are large, densely-foliaged and/or shallow-rooted.
- If needed, examine and repair roofs, gutters, window caulking, and insulation.

- Keep large flashlights, extra batteries and/or lanterns on hand in case of an electrical failure.
- Turn off automated sprinkler systems when rain is expected.

PV Transit information is now available on Google Maps! Through the technology of Google Maps, Google's Transit Trip Planner integrates PV Transit stop, route and



## **Business License Renewals Due**

s a friendly reminder, business licenses expire December 31, 2012. Please renew your business license by January 31, 2013, in order to avoid late penalties. Business licenses are required for any business conducted in the City. If you do not receive your license renewal by mail in December, or are a new business requiring licensing, please contact the City's Finance Department at (310) 378-0383.

Home occupation businesses are permitted under certain limited conditions to ensure there are no impacts on neighbors. If you operate any business from your home, you need to secure a home occupation permit for 2013. If you operate a business solely from a location outside the city, you should use that location's address for any state licenses or correspondence so that you are not required to get a City license as well.
