OVERVIEW

During April of 2020, there were eight Part I Crimes; three were residential burglaries, and five were thefts of property.

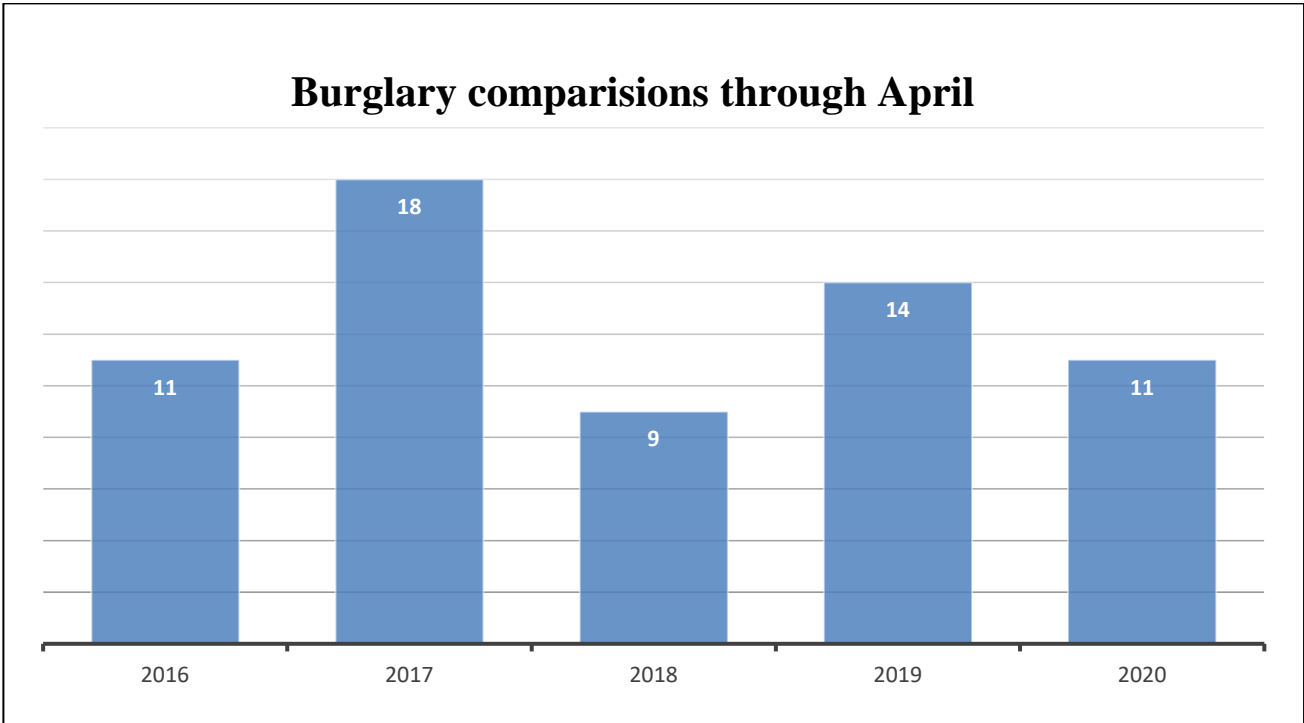
The burglaries occurred while the residents were either away from their home or the residence was under construction. The suspects in this first case pried open the front door to gain entry. Once inside, the suspects ransacked several rooms and removed the victim's property. In the second case, the suspects entered a residence under construction. Once inside, the unsecured residence / construction site, the suspects located a secured lock box located in a bedroom of the residence. The suspects cut the locks to the secured lock box and removed construction equipment. In the third and final case, the suspects entered a construction site by tearing down a fence securing the site. Once on the site, the suspects cut a locked container which secured construction tools. The suspects removed multiple construction tools and fled the area.

Of the larcenies, three were from secured / unsecured vehicles where the suspects removed victims' property and fled the area undetected. In the fourth case, the suspects entered an unsecured parking structure and removed two bicycles that were secured together by a cable lock. In the fifth and final case, packages were removed from the front porch of a home.
