OVERVIEW

During February of 2020, there were six Part I Crimes; two were residential burglaries, one commercial burglary, one attempt burglary, one theft of property, and one stolen vehicle.

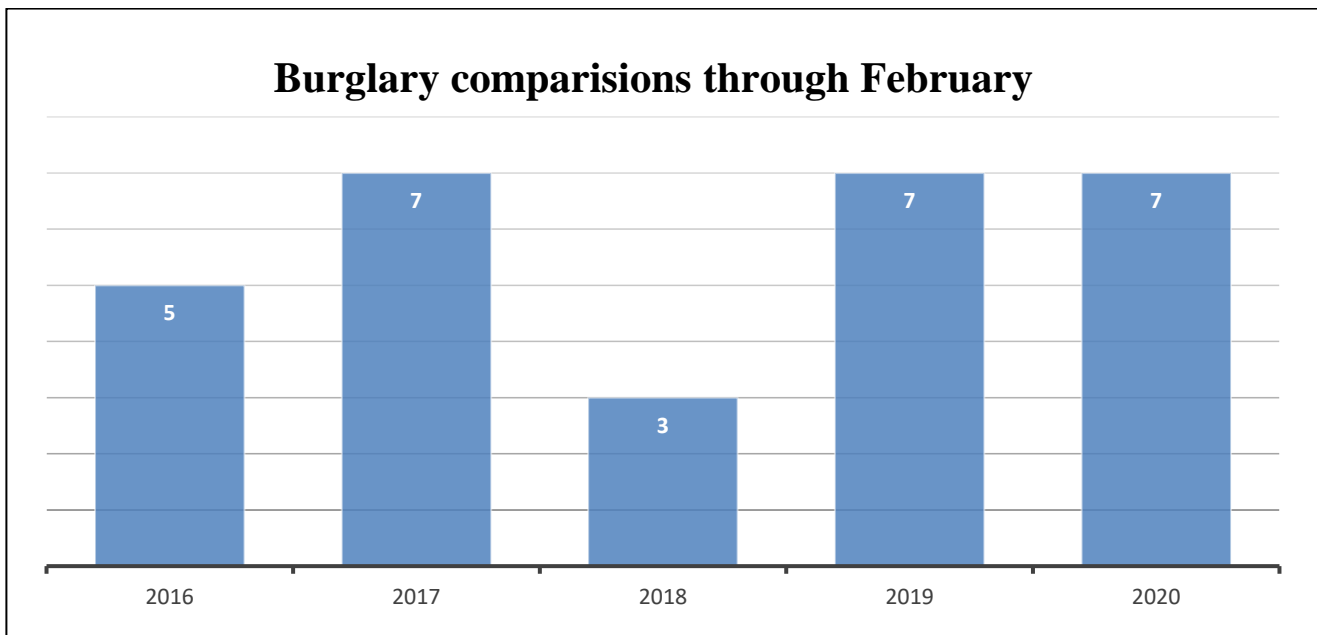
Of the burglaries, two occurred while the residents were away from their homes. The suspects in the first case, smashed a rear window to gain entry into the residence and ransacked multiple rooms. In the second case, the suspects entered the residence through an unlocked door and ransacked multiple rooms. In the third case (attempt only), the suspects attempt to gain entry into the residence by smashing a rear sliding glass door. The suspects are unsuccessful in gaining entry into the residence and fled the area. In the fourth and final case, the suspects kicked open the front door of a business. Once inside, the suspects were selective in their loot and fled the area on foot.

Of the larceny, the suspect(s) entered an unsecure parking structure. The suspect(s) cut the lock which secured two electric powered bicycles and fled the area with victim's property.

The vehicle was reported stolen from 3301 Via Campesina (Palos Verdes Golf Club). A short time later, PVEPD Officers observed the vehicle within the city where a vehicle pursuit ensued and the suspect was ultimately arrested.
