OVERVIEW

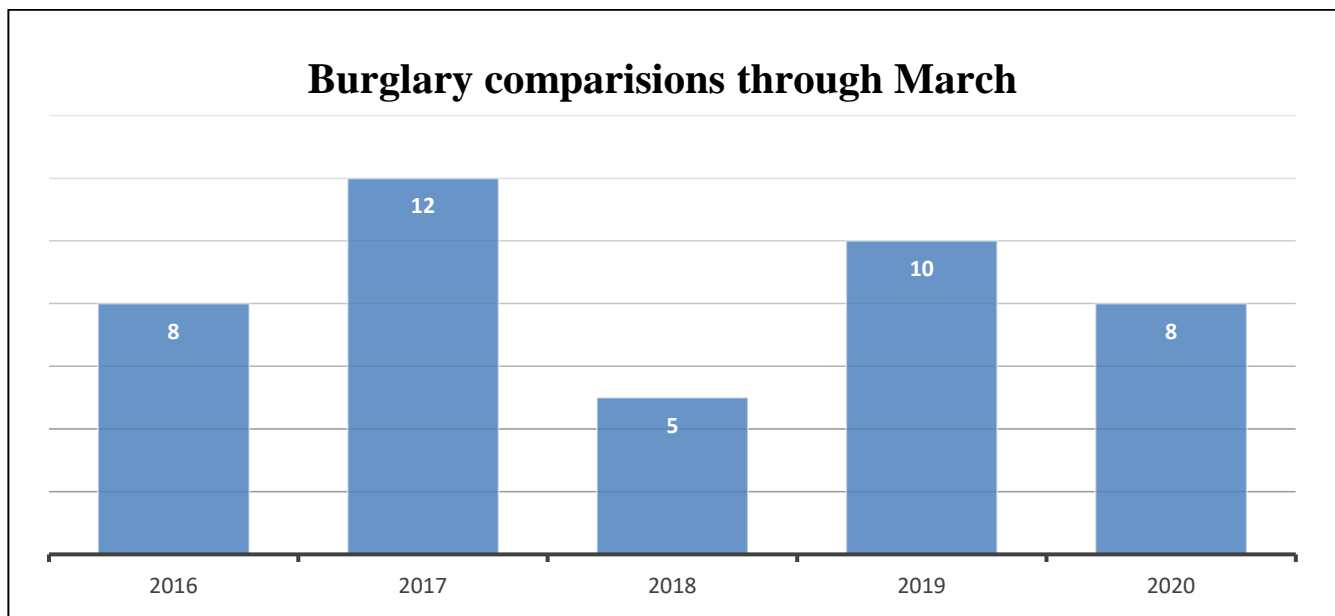
During March of 2020, there were three Part I Crimes; one was a residential burglary, and two were thefts of property.

The burglary occurred while the residents were away from their home. The suspects in this case scaled a side fence to enter the backyard of the property. The suspects proceeded to smash a rear glass window pane to a set of French doors to gain entry into the residence and ransacked multiple rooms.

Of the larcenies, one involved the theft of property from an open/unsecure residential garage. In the second larceny, the suspect(s) removed a package from the front porch of the residence.
