OVERVIEW

During May of 2020, there were seven Part I Crimes; two were residential burglaries, and five were thefts of property.

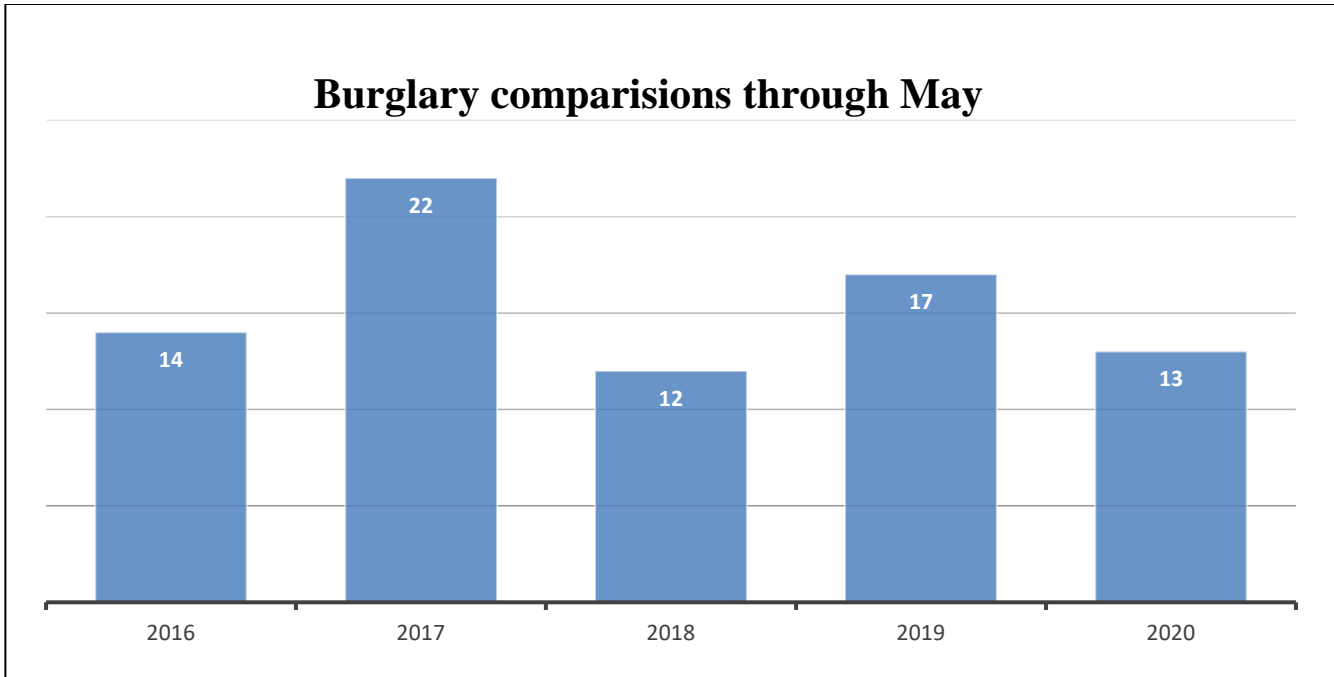
Of the burglaries, one occurred while the resident was away from their home. The suspects in this case entered the residence through an unsecure front door and removed items from the residence. In the second case, the suspects entered a residence that was under construction. Once inside the unsecure construction site, the suspects remove construction tools and fled the area.

Of the larcenies, two were from unsecure vehicles where the suspects entered the victims' vehicles and removed property. In the third case, the suspects removed the victim's mail from a curbside mailbox. In the fourth case, a suspect known to the victim removed property from inside their residence. In the fifth and final case, a package was removed from the victim's front porch.
