OVERVIEW

During November of 2019, there were ten Part I Crimes; five were residential burglaries, four were thefts from vehicles, and one was a theft of property.

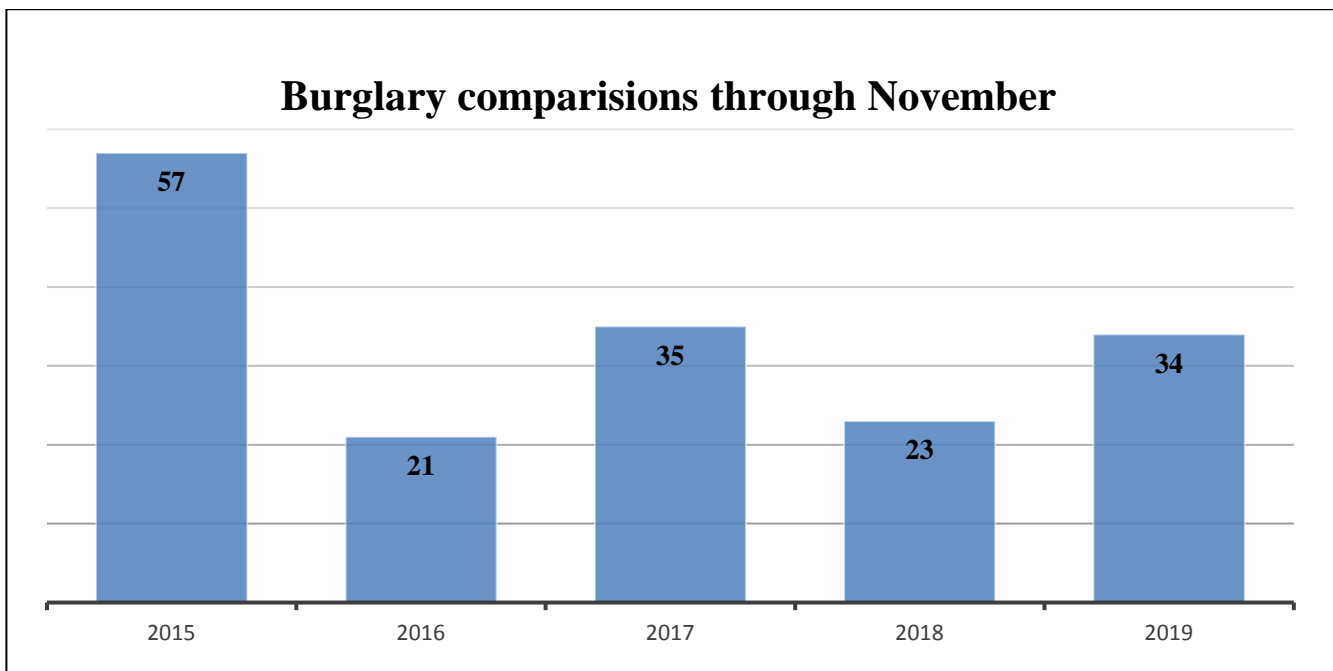
Of the burglaries, four occurred while the residents were away from their homes. In three of these cases, the suspects gained entry to the residences by smashing a rear window and ransacking the residences. In another cases, the suspects gained entry through an unsecure side window and ransacked the residence. In the last case, the residence was under construction; entry was gain via the garage.

In two of these burglary cases, PVEPD Detectives tracked down the suspects who were staying / residing in the city of Hawthorne. Detectives surveilled the area and ultimately observed the suspects enter the suspect vehicle that had been captured on video surveillance. PVEPD Detectives attempted to stop the vehicle and a short pursuit ensued; two suspects were ultimately arrested. As a result of the arrest, PVEPD Detectives recovered property from the suspects associated with the burglaries that occurred in the city of PVE. The case was filed with the Los Angeles County DA's Office.

Of the larcenies, two were from secured vehicles where the suspect(s) broke into the vehicles and removed the victims' property. Two were from unsecured vehicles where the suspects gained entry and removed the victims' property. The fifth larceny was a package theft from a resident's front porch. It was determined the suspect followed a delivery truck and removed the property from the front porch after the package had been delivered.
