OVERVIEW

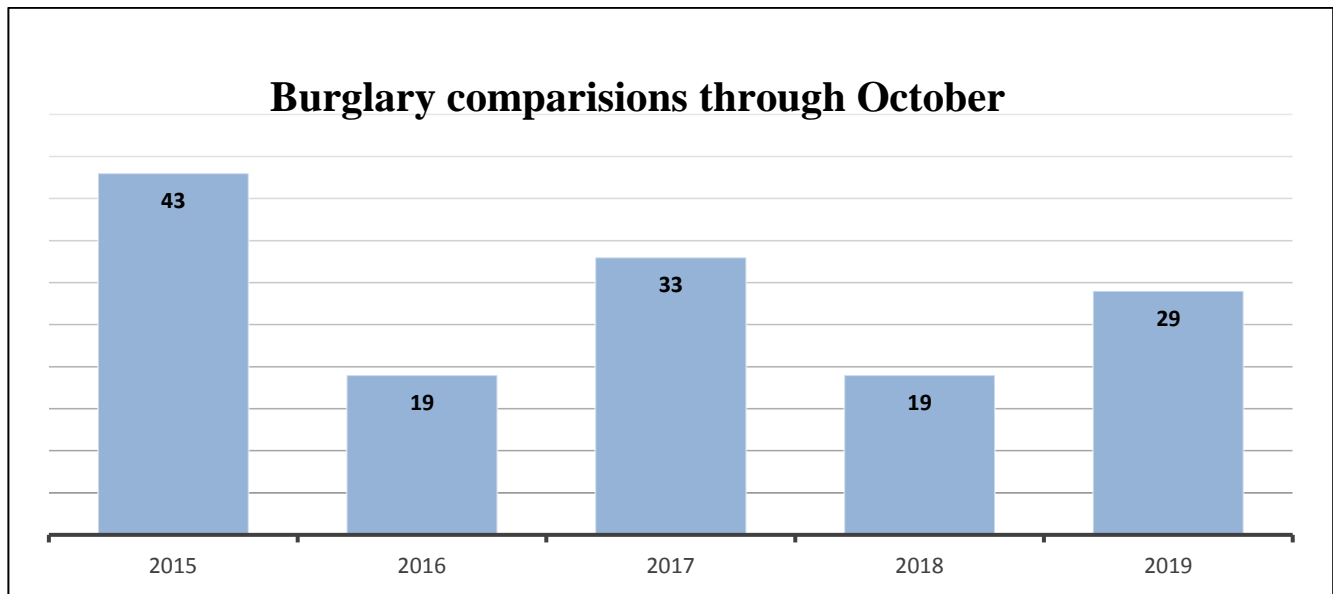
During October of 2019, there were five Part I Crimes; one was a robbery, and four were thefts from vehicles.

The robbery occurred at a PVE residence between an adult-suspect and his mother. In this case, the suspect was residing at the residence when a verbal argument ensued between the suspect and his mother. The argument soon turned physical when the suspect forcibly took his mother's cellular telephone and wallet. PVEPD Officers responded to the location where they were able to arrest the suspect without further incident. A search of the residence resulted in the recovery of multiple un-registered firearms including two AR-15 assault rifles, along with a loaded semi-automatic handgun belonging to the suspect. The case was filled with the Los Angeles County DA's Office.

Of the larcenies, two were from unsecure vehicles where the suspect(s) entered the vehicles and removed the victims' property. The third larceny was from a secured vehicle where the suspect(s) broke the driver's side door lock, entered the vehicle, and removed the victim's property. The fourth larceny was from an open garage where the suspect(s) removed a bicycle from the interior of the garage.
