#### **CRIME DATA**

During December of 2020, there were eight Part I Crimes; two residential burglaries, five thefts from motor vehicles, and one theft of property (mail).


In these two burglary cases, the suspects gained entry to the residences by smashing a rear sliding glass door / French door with an unknown object. Suspects ransacked multiple rooms throughout the residence and were selective in loot (jewelry).

Of the thefts from motor vehicles, two were from secured vehicles and three were unsecured vehicles. Of the secured vehicles, the suspects used an unknown tool to manipulate the locking mechanism on the door handle to gain entry causing significant damage. In these cases, the suspects removed personal items and fled the area undetected. In the cases of unsecured vehicles, the suspects gained entry into the vehicles and removed victim's property.

The theft of property occurred from a residential mailbox. The suspects in this case remove mail from the victim's mail box. PVEPD Officers later located and recovered the opened mail in the 1800 block of Dalton Road. The recovered property was returned to the victim.
