## CRIME DATA

During January of 2021, there were ten Part I Crimes; four residential burglaries, four thefts from a motor vehicle, one theft of property, and one robbery.

In two of these burglary cases, the suspects gained entry to residences by smashing a rear sliding glass door / French door with an unknown object. Suspects ransacked multiple rooms throughout the residence and were selective in loot. In the third burglary case, the suspects entered an enclosed, secure parking structure by an unknown means. Once inside, the suspects proceeded to remove the locking mechanism securing multiple bicycles. The suspects fled the area with the victims' property in an unknown direction. In the final burglary case, the suspects gained access to an open residential garage door. The suspects removed the victims' property undetected and fled the area.

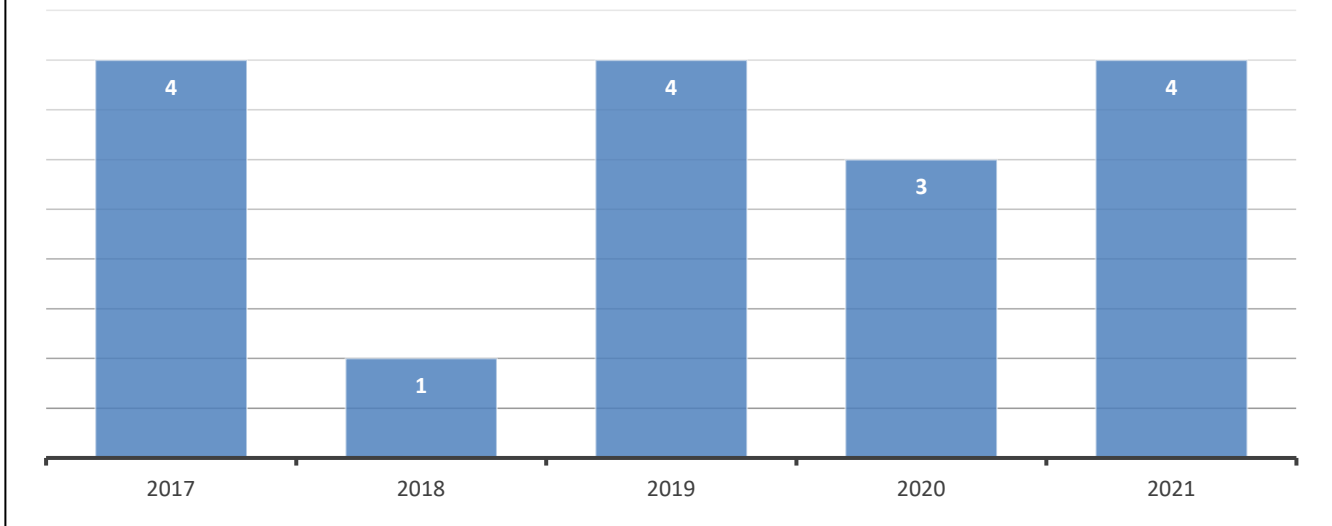
Of the thefts from motor vehicles, three of the vehicles were unsecured and one vehicle was secured. Of the unsecured thefts from vehicles, the suspects entered the vehicles through an unlocked door and removed the victims' property. Of the theft from the secured vehicle, the suspects used an unknown tool to break the glass to the front passenger side window to gain entry, causing significant damage to the vehicle. The suspects removed personal items without detection and fled the area undetected.

Of the theft of property, the victim stated there were multiple care providers at the residence over the past year. During a recent inventory search of the residence, the victim noticed property missing from the residence.

In the case of the robbery, a suspect who the victim knew, entered the residence uninvited and confronted the victim along with an additional guest. The victim attempted to record the incident via their cellular telephone, when the suspect grabbed the telephone from the victim's grasp. The suspect then threw the cellular telephone across the room, pepper sprayed the victim, and fled the location on foot to an awaiting vehicle.
