CRIME DATA

During March of 2021, there were seven Part I Crimes; one residential burglary, three thefts from a motor vehicle, one arson, and two property thefts.

During the one burglary, unknown suspect(s) gain entry into the residence by smashing the rear sliding glass door that leads into the master bedroom. Upon entering the residence, suspect(s) ransacked multiple bedrooms and removed property undetected.


Of the thefts from motor vehicles, one was from an unlocked vehicle, and two were from locked vehicles.

Of the larcenies, the first involved the victim's adult child inviting multiple friends (NFD) to the residence while the victim was away. An unknown friend/suspect removed multiple items from the residence undetected and fled the area.

In the second larceny, the victim deposited mail (personal check) in a USPS drop box located in the City of Palos Verdes Estates. The suspect in this case subsequently removed the deposited item and fled the area undetected.

The last Part One crime was arson, in which officers responded to a call of a vehicle fire in the 3100 block of Paseo Del Campo. Upon investigation, it was believed that an accelerant was used on the inside of the vehicle. The owner of the car later reported it stolen.






