CRIME DATA

In July of 2021, there were four Part 1 crimes: two residential burglaries, one theft from a motor vehicle, and one theft of property.

Of the first burglary, one occurred during a six-month time frame when the victim was away on business. The suspect(s) shut off power to the residence and deactivated the alarm system prior to prying open a side door with an unknown tool to gain entry. Once inside, the suspects removed the victim’s property without detection.

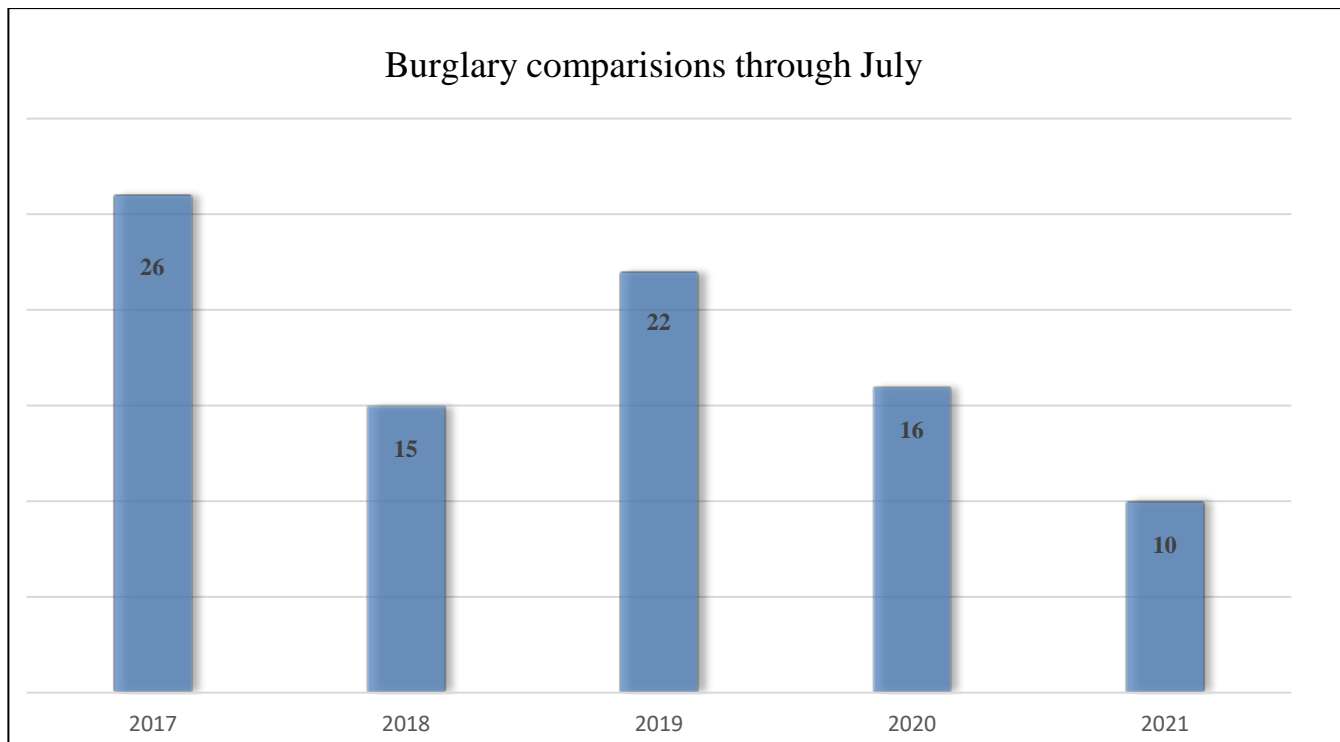
In the second burglary, the suspect entered the residence through an unlocked rear sliding glass door, however, the suspect was startled by the homeowner’s dog and fled the location. As the suspect fled the location, they removed a golf club from the garage area of the residence, which was captured on home video surveillance cameras.

After the burglary occurred, PVEPD Officers and Detectives responded to the residence and collected evidence, and utilized the victim’s home video surveillance camera footage to identify the suspect, who was subsequently arrested in the weeks to follow. During a jailhouse interview of the suspect, he ultimately admitted to committing the burglary.

The theft from a motor vehicle occurred when the suspect(s) manipulated the driver’s side door lock to gain entry. Suspect(s) entered the vehicle, removed the victim’s property, and fled the area undetected.

Of the theft of property, a patron at a restaurant left their wallet on top of a dining table before leaving. An unknown suspect who also patronized the restaurant was captured on video surveillance taking the wallet from the table. The suspect then fled the area with the victim’s property.

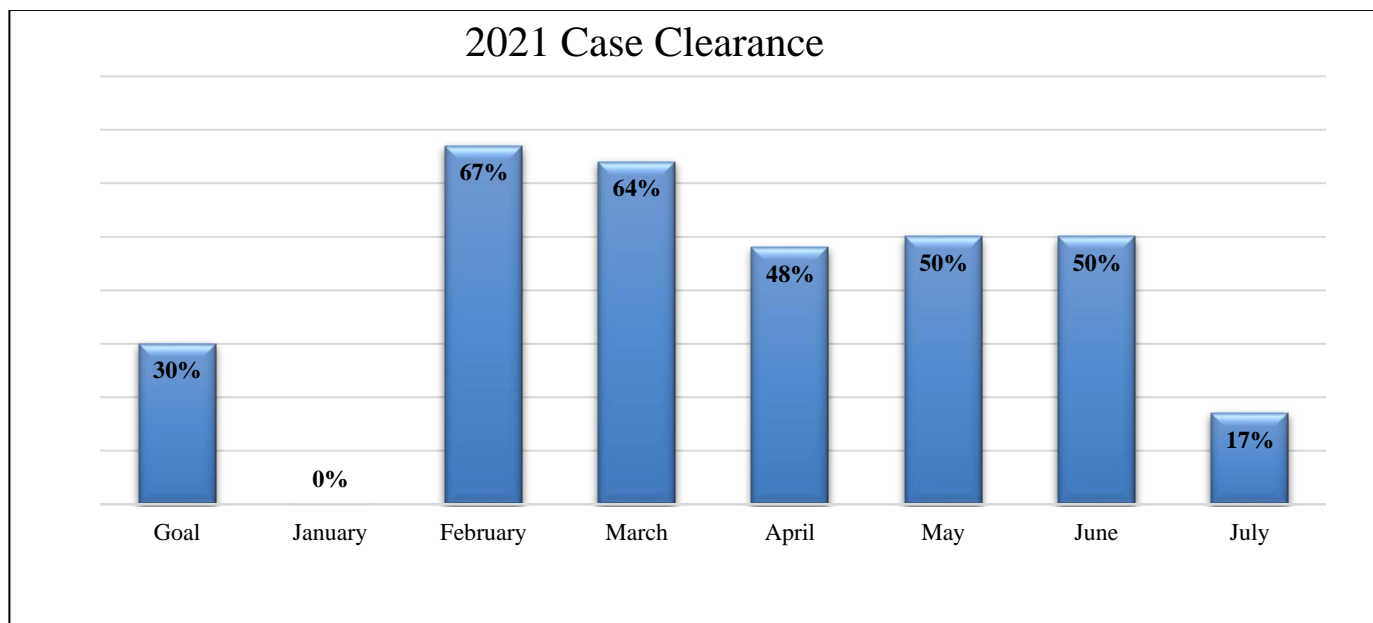

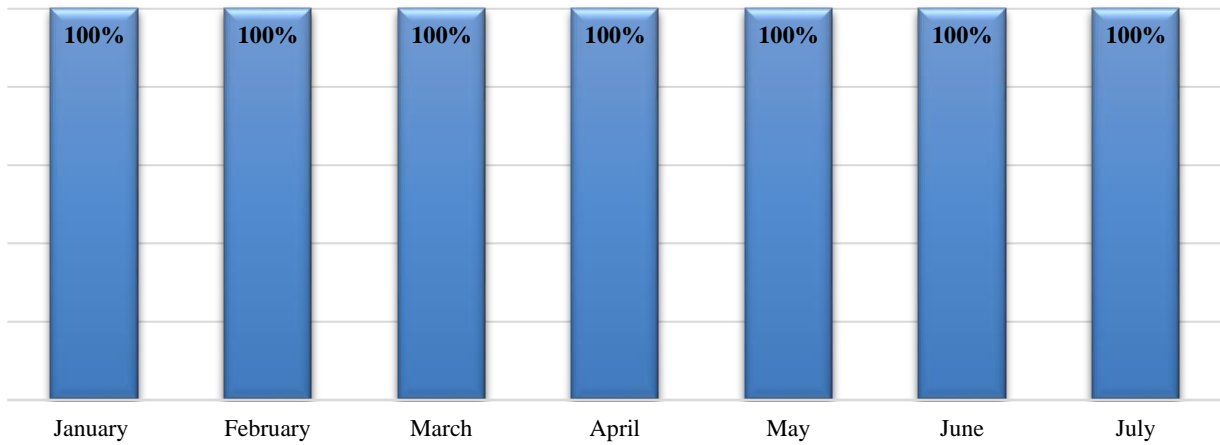
