#### **CRIME DATA**

In August of 2021, there were six Part 1 crimes: two residential burglaries, three thefts of mail, and one theft of property.


The first burglary occurred during a one-year time-frame, when the victim was away on business. The suspect(s) gained entry by smashing the rear master bathroom window and ransacked the master bedroom / master bathroom. The suspect(s) fled the location undetected with the victim's property.

In the second burglary, the suspect(s) entered the residence by smashing a window pane located on the front door of the residence. Suspect(s) unlocked the door and proceeded to the master bedroom and removed two rings from the top of a dresser. The suspect(s) fled the location with the victim's property undetected.

The thefts of mail occurred at multiple locations throughout the city of PVE. The suspect(s) in these cases removed the victims' mail from secured and un-secured mailboxes. In all of these cases, the suspect(s) fled the location undetected.

Of the theft of property, the suspect was known to the victim and in a dating relationship. The suspect removed property from the residence without permission. The victim notified PVEPD Officers after noticing the property missing from the residence. PVEPD Officers responded to both the suspect's and victim's residences and recovered some of the property after conducting their investigation.


