CRIME DATA

In September of 2021, there were ten Part 1 crimes: three residential burglaries, one rape, two thefts from motor vehicles, one theft of property, one theft of motor vehicle parts, one theft of a motor vehicle, and one attempt theft of a motor vehicle.

The first burglary occurred at a construction site where the suspect(s) used bolt cutters to cut the lock to the security gate. Once inside the construction site, the suspect(s) removed the victim’s property and fled the location undetected.

In the second burglary, the suspect(s) removed the perimeter fence leading to the construction site. The suspect(s) removed the victim’s property and fled the location undetected.

In the third and final burglary, the suspect(s) smashed the glass portion of a door with an unknown object. Upon gaining entry to the residence, the suspect(s) ransacked multiple rooms, removed the victim's property, and fled the location.

The sexual assault involved a suspect and victim who had a previous relationship. Detectives have investigated the crime and there is no known risk to the general public.

The thefts from motor vehicles occurred from two unlocked vehicles where the suspect(s) gained access and removed the victims' property. The suspect(s) fled the area undetected.

Regarding the property theft, the suspect removed multiple pieces of property, including jewelry and U.S. currency, from a residence undetected.

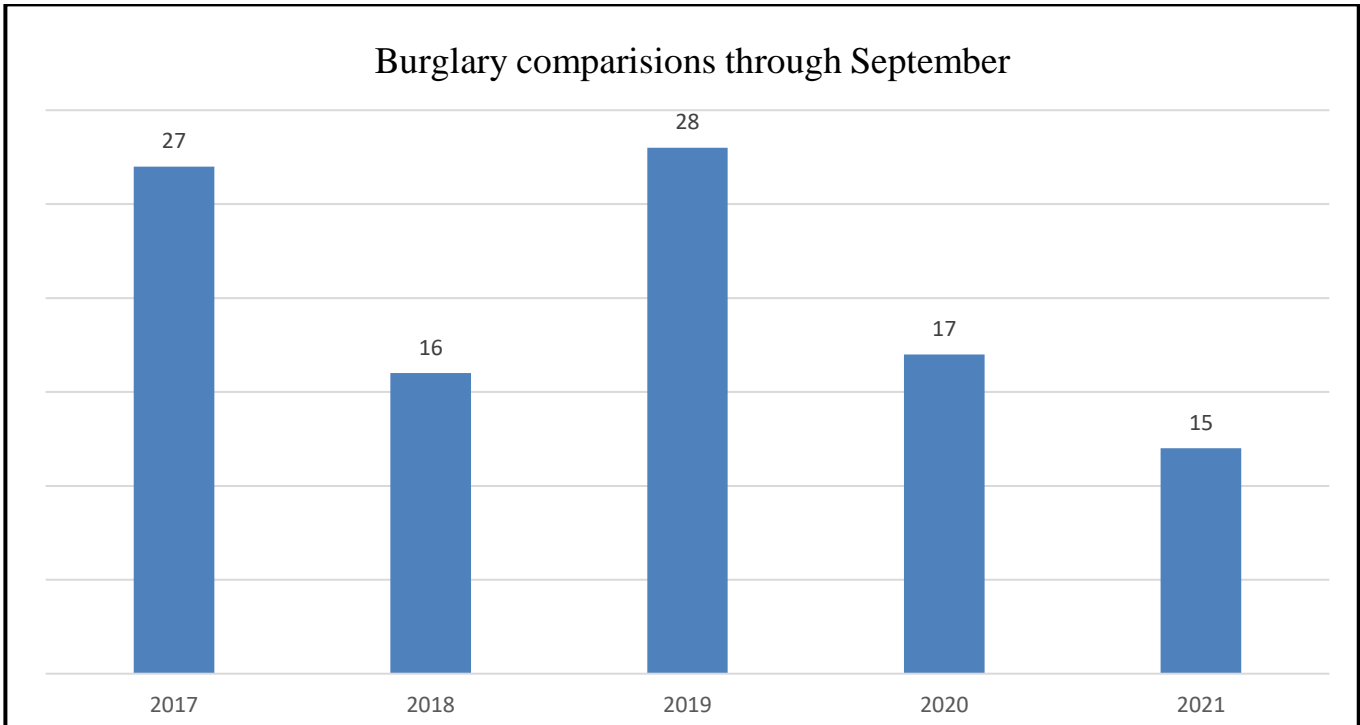
The theft of motor vehicle parts occurred from a parked vehicle. The suspect(s) removed the vehicle's catalytic converter and fled the area undetected.

The theft of motor vehicle occurred when the owner of the vehicle left the keys inside the vehicle and left the area. The suspect(s) entered the vehicle and fled the area undetected.

The attempted theft of a motor vehicle occurred when the suspect(s) gained entry into a secured vehicle by unknown means. The suspect(s) used shaved keys in an attempt to start the vehicle but were unsuccessful. The suspect(s) then fled the area undetected.

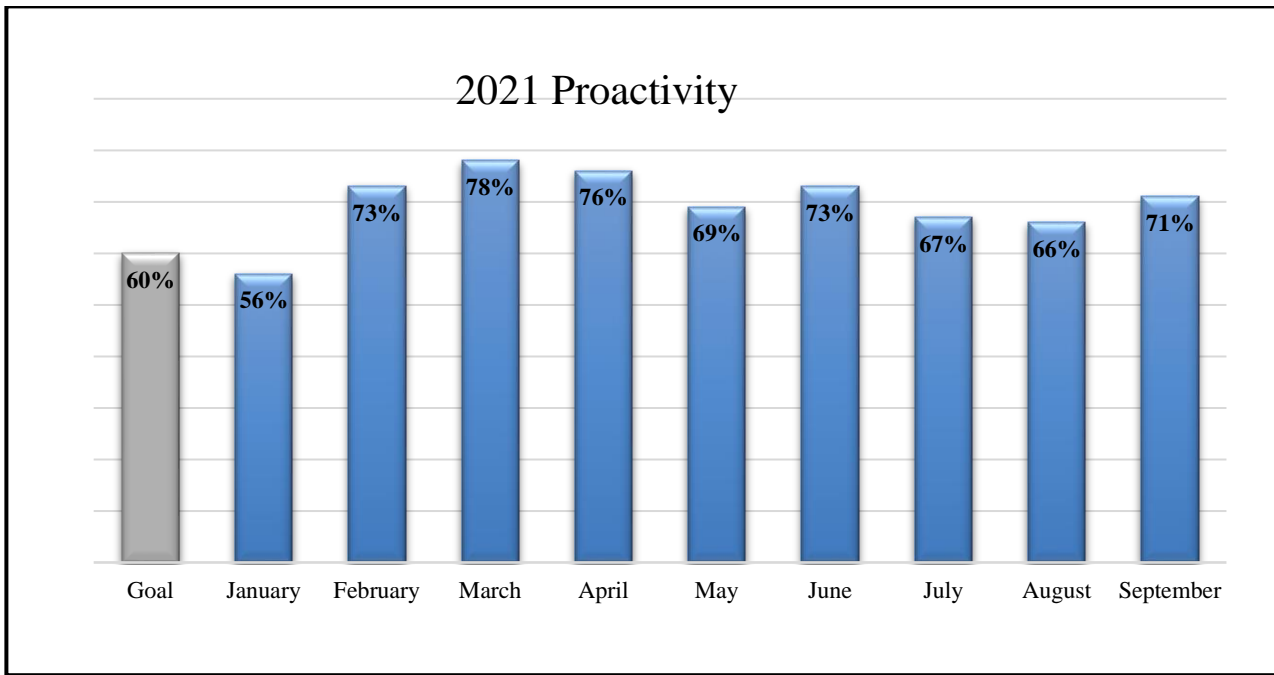

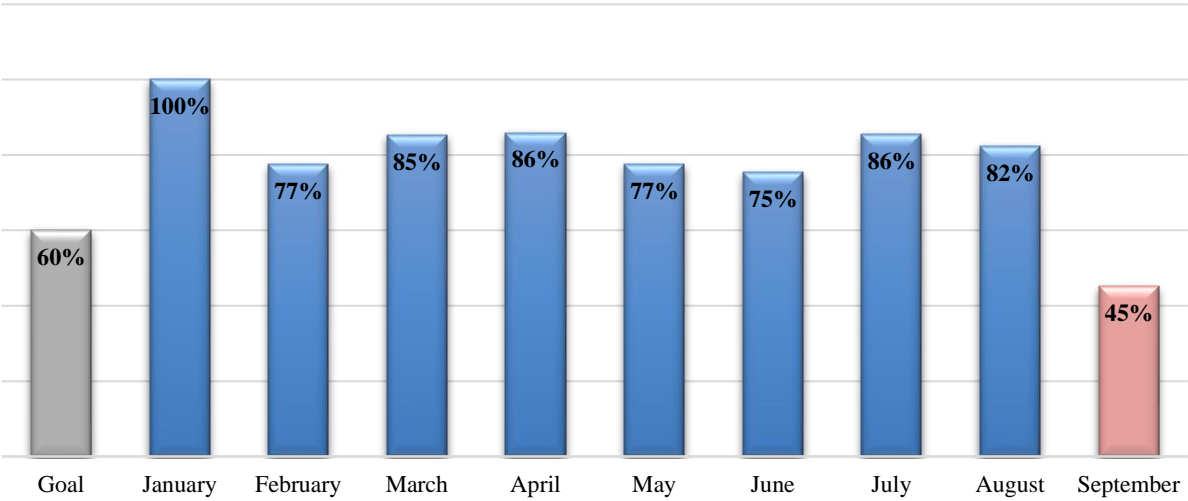

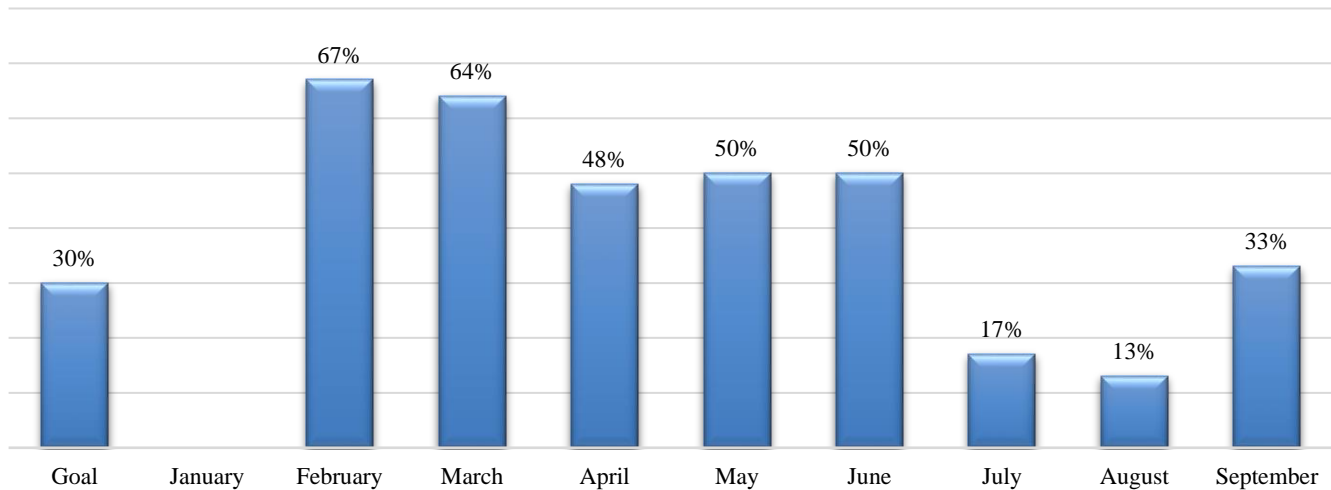

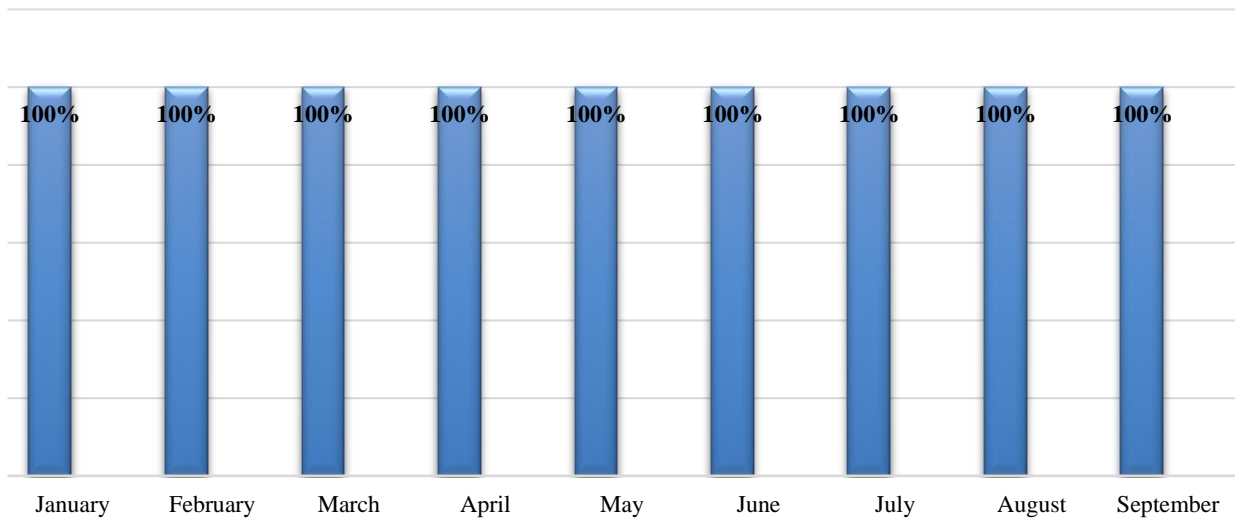
