CRIME DATA

In November of 2021, there were thirteen Part 1 crimes: five residential burglaries, one arson on school grounds, six thefts from a motor vehicle, and one theft of property.

In the first two burglary cases, the suspect(s) smashed a rear master bedroom glass door window to gain entry into the residences. Once inside, the suspect(s) ransacked and removed the victims' property and fled the location undetected.

In the third and fourth burglary cases, the suspect(s) smashed the window pane to the front door of one residence, and the side door window pane of the second residence. Once inside, the suspect(s) removed the victims' property and fled the location undetected.

In the fifth and last burglary case, the suspect(s) used a pry tool to open the locked door to the residence. Once inside, the suspect(s) removed the victim's property and fled the location undetected.


In the arson case, unknown suspects entered the PVHS campus after hours. While on campus, one of the suspects ignites a piece of paper pinned to an outdoor bulletin board with a lighter. Suspects fled the area in an unknown direction.

Of the first two thefts from motor vehicles, two occurred from unlocked vehicles where the suspect(s) gained access and removed the victims' property. The suspect(s) fled the area undetected.

Of the next four thefts from motor vehicles, two vehicles had the windows smashed where the suspect(s) were able to gain entry and removed the victims' property. The suspect(s) fled the area undetected. The second two thefts from motor vehicles occurred when the suspect(s) used unknown mechanisms/pry tools to gain entry into the vehicles and removed the victims' property. The suspect(s) fled the area undetected.

Of the property theft, the suspect(s) removed mail from the victim's mailbox and fled the area undetected.
