CRIME DATA

In December of 2021, there were thirteen Part 1 crimes: Seven residential burglaries, one stolen vehicle, one theft from a motor vehicle, one attempted theft from a motor vehicle, and three thefts of property.

In the first burglary case, the suspect entered the residence through an unsecured garage door. The suspect began turning on outside lights to the residence which woke the victim. The victim confronted the suspect who ultimately departed the residence without further incident. PVEPD Officers were called and responded to the area and later placed the suspect under arrest just outside of the victim’s residence.

In the next four burglary cases, the suspect(s) gained entry by smashing a lower level window/door panels. The suspect(s) ransacked rooms and were selective in their loot. The suspect(s) fled the area undetected.

Of the two remaining burglaries, the suspect(s) in both of these cases gained access to the rear portion of both residences by force. Once inside the residences, the alarm system was activated and the suspect(s) fled the area undetected.

Of the theft of a motor vehicle, three suspects entered the victim’s unlocked vehicle. The keys to the vehicle were left inside by the victim, and the suspects fled the area with the vehicle.

Of the theft from a motor vehicle, unknown suspect(s) smashed the rear passenger side window to gain entry. Suspect(s) removed the victim’s property and fled the area undetected.

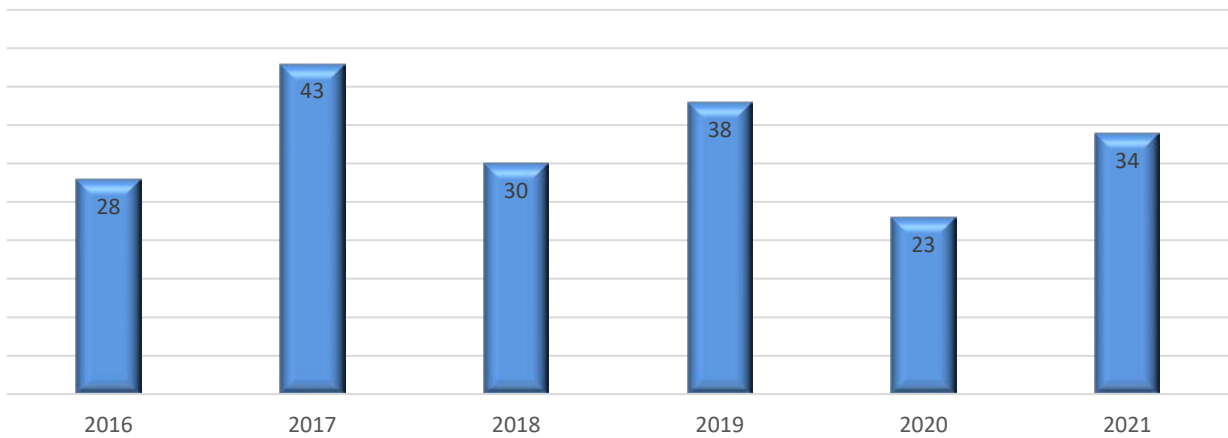
In the attempted theft from a motor vehicle, the suspect attempted to gain entry by using a drill to break the vehicle’s door lock. Residents observed the attempted break-in and contacted PVEPD. Officers arrived on the scene and located the suspect who was later arrested.

Of the first of three thefts, one occurred at the victim’s residence when they noticed the property was missing after a moving company had delivered furniture to the residence. In the second theft, unknown suspect(s) removed packages from the porch of the victim and fled the area undetected. In the last theft, two suspects removed mail and packages from an unsecured mail room. PVEPD Officers initiated a traffic stop on the suspects and ultimately recovered the stolen property and placed the suspects under arrest.

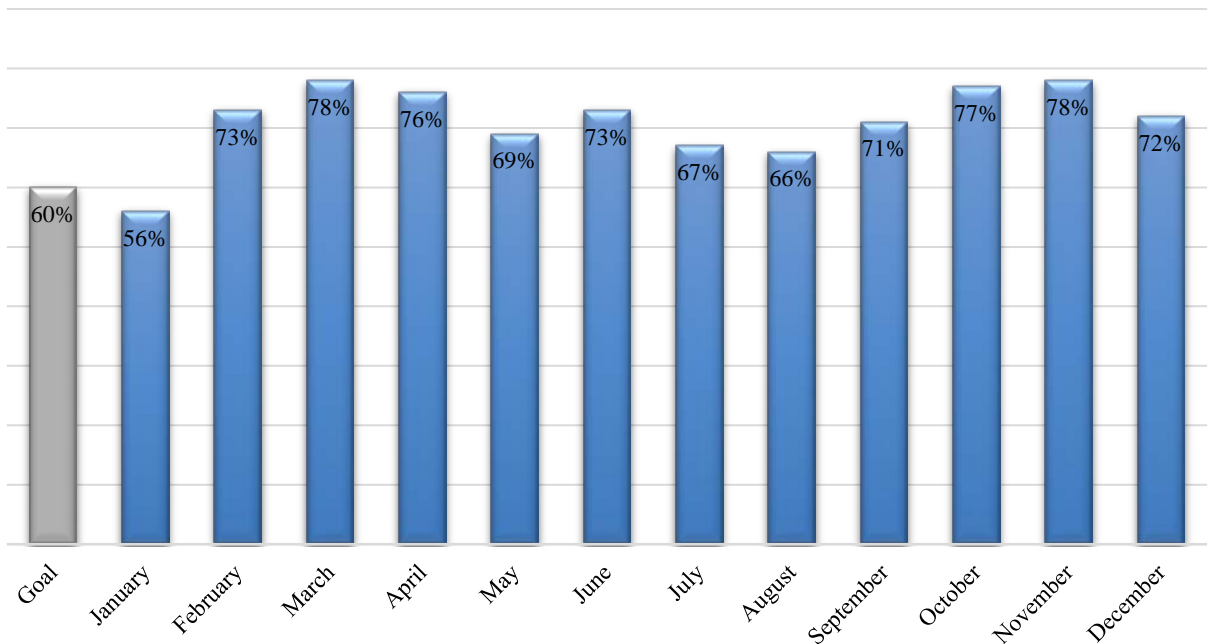

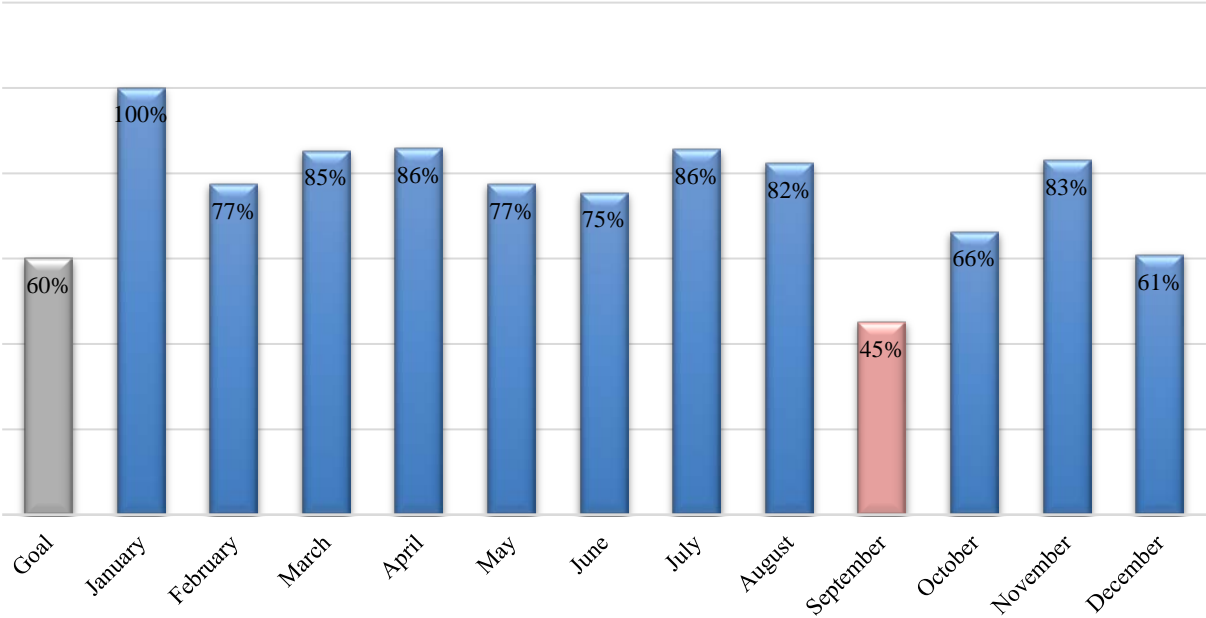

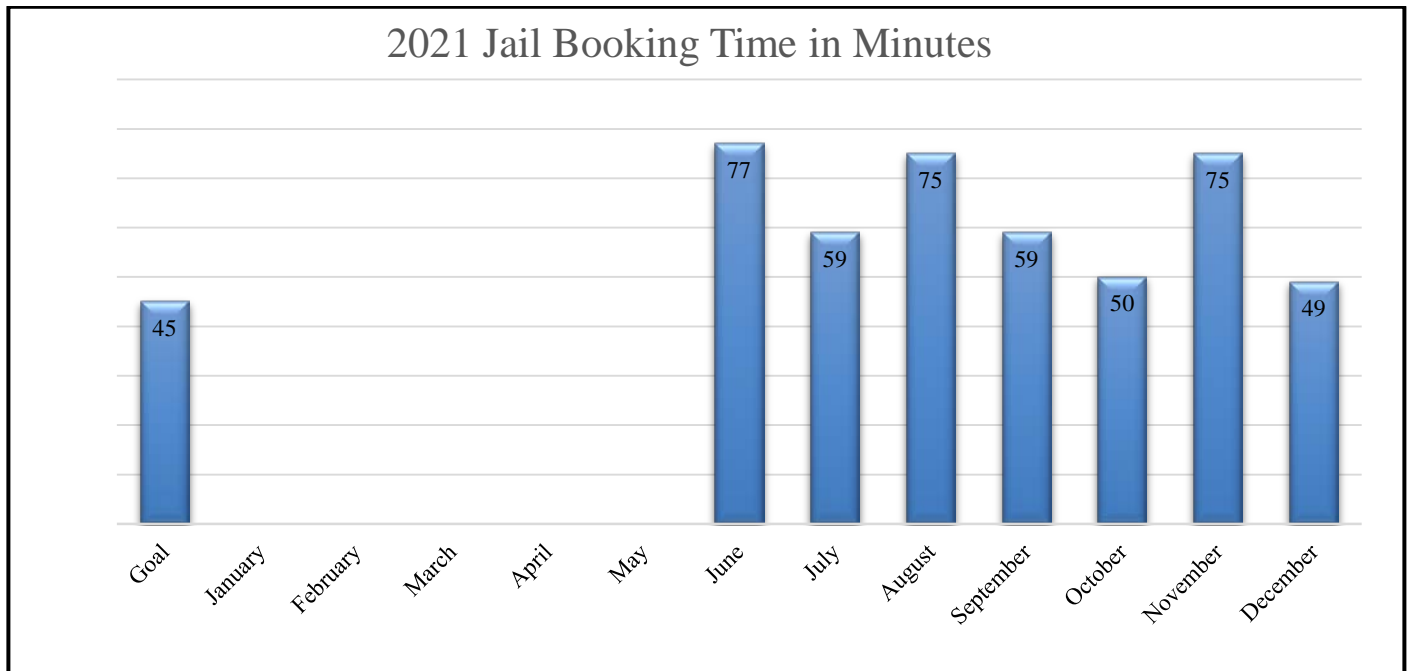

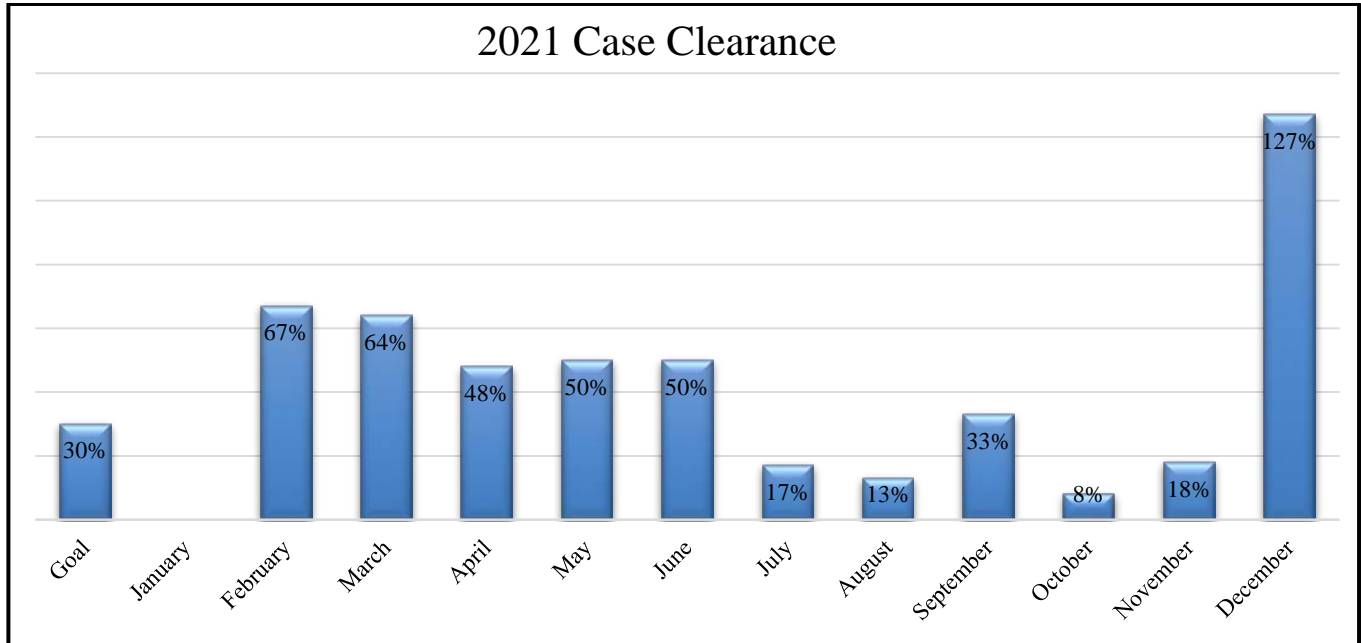

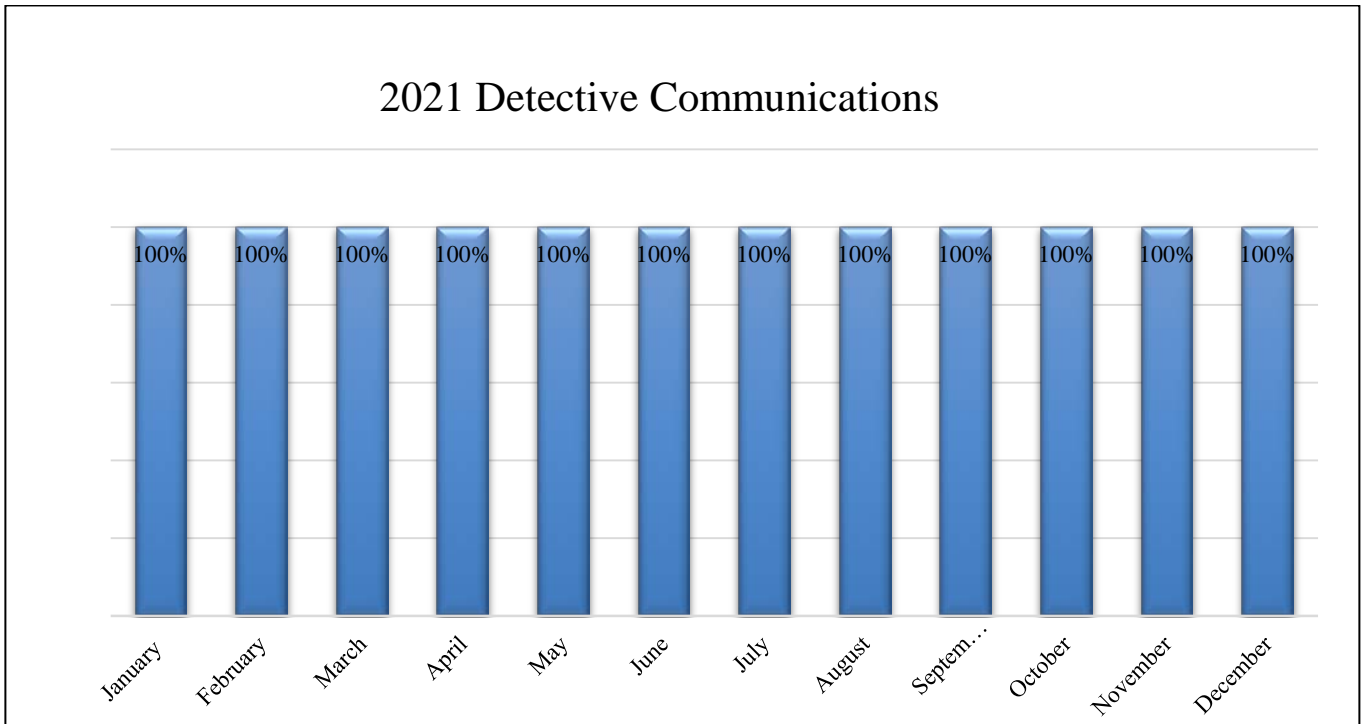
