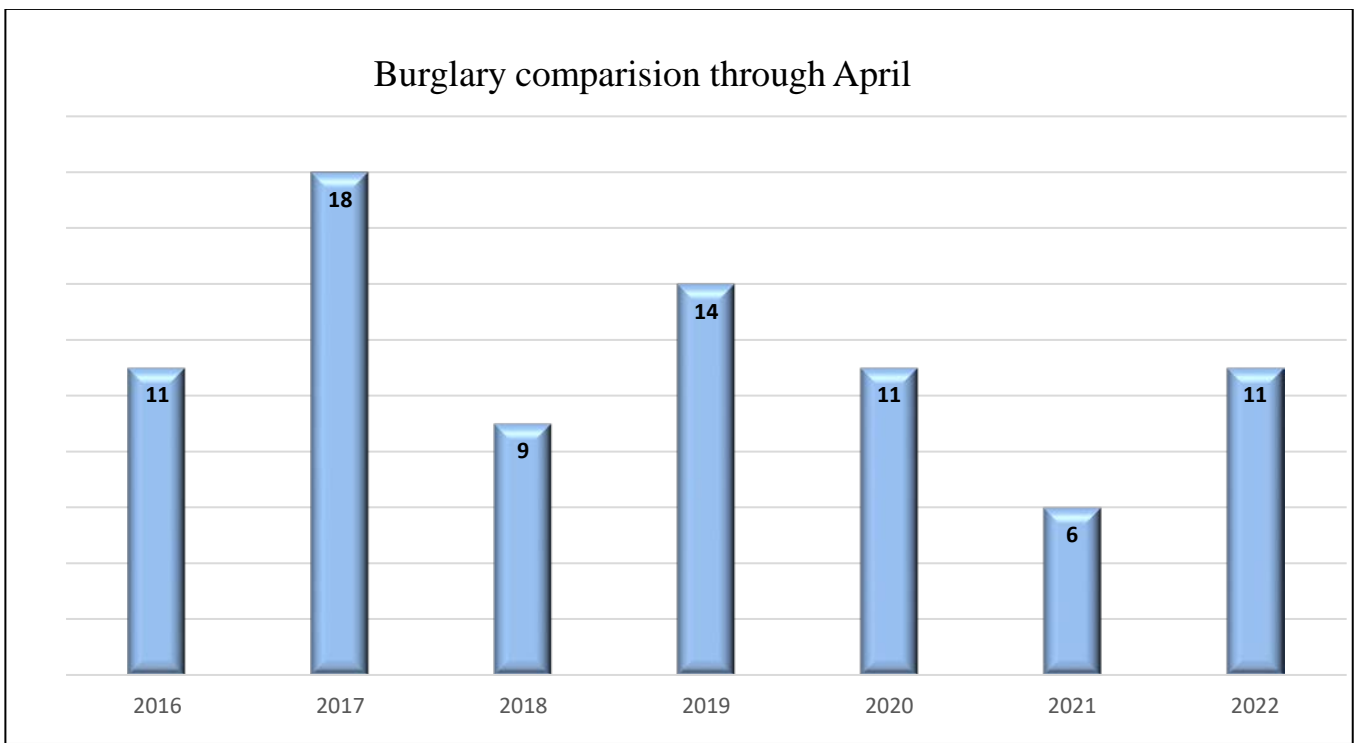
In April of 2022, there were two Part 1 crimes: two larcenies (thefts).

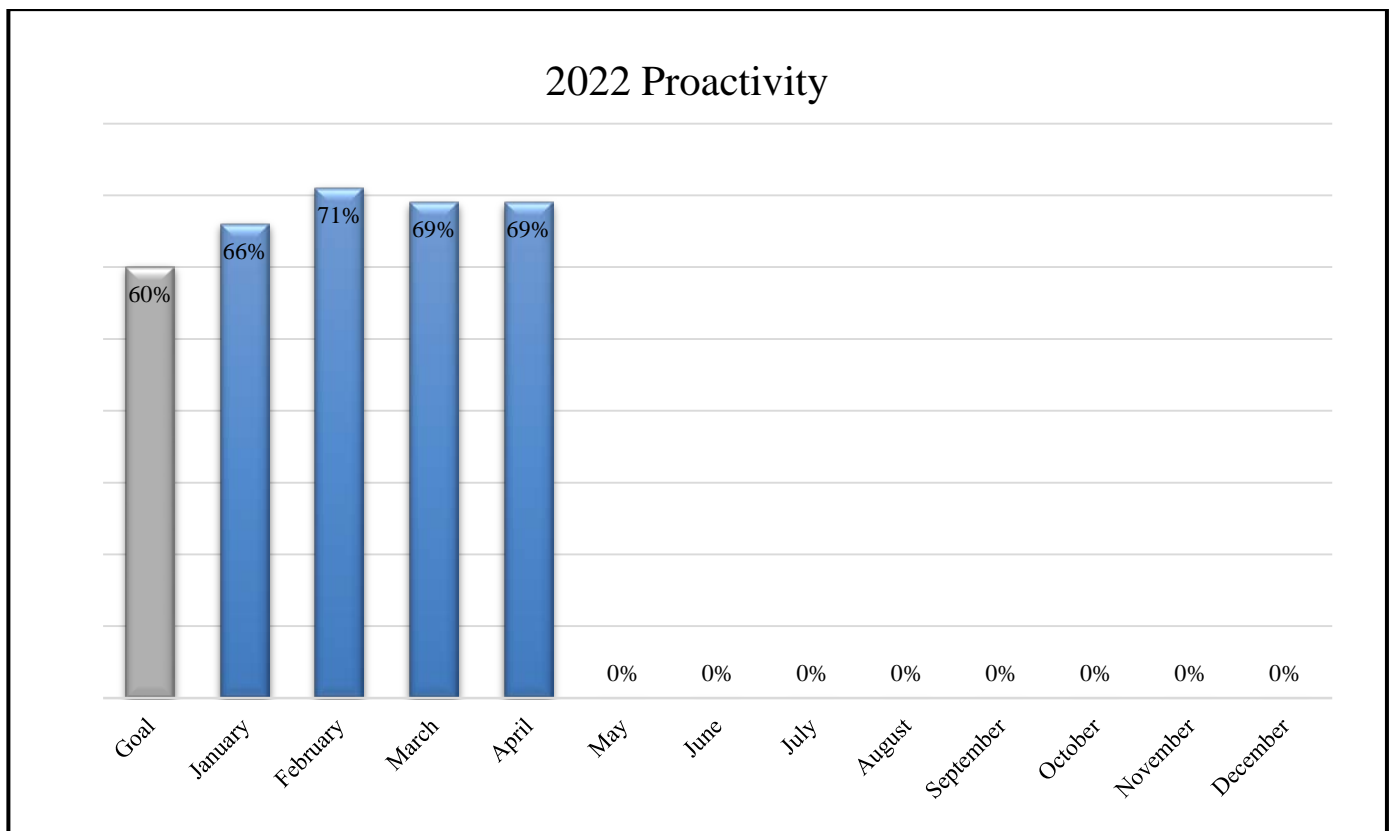

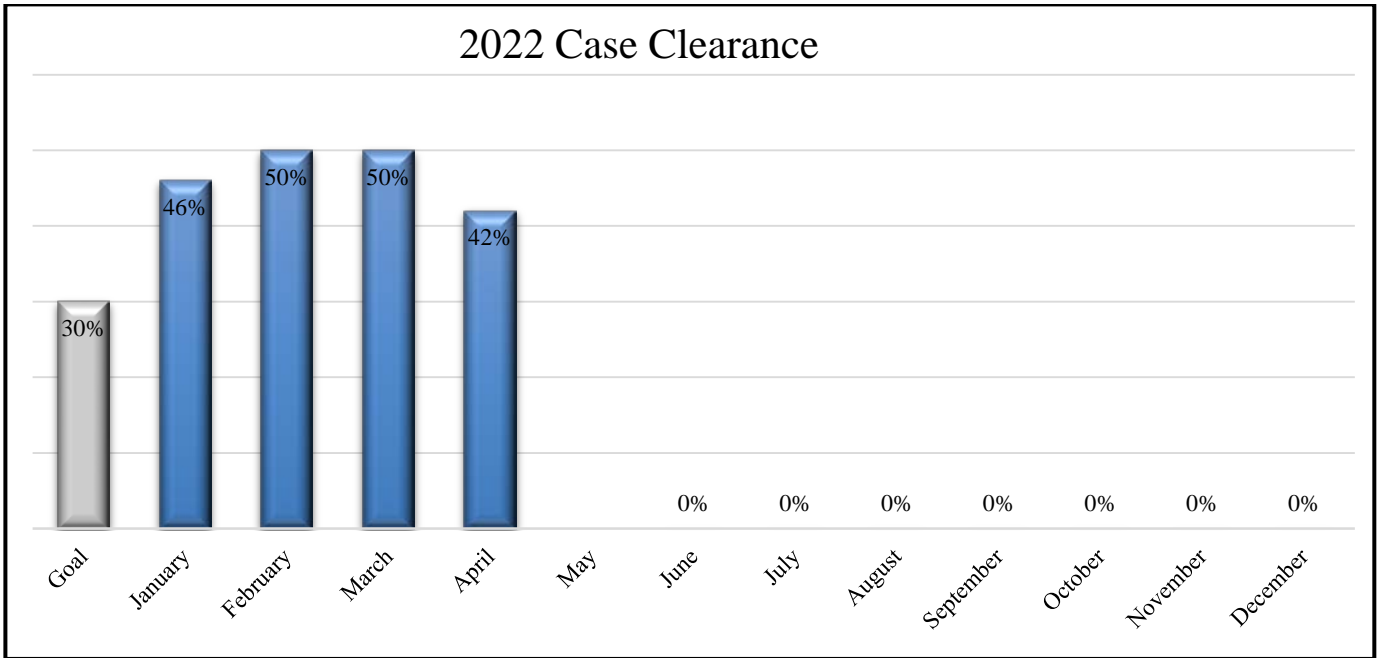

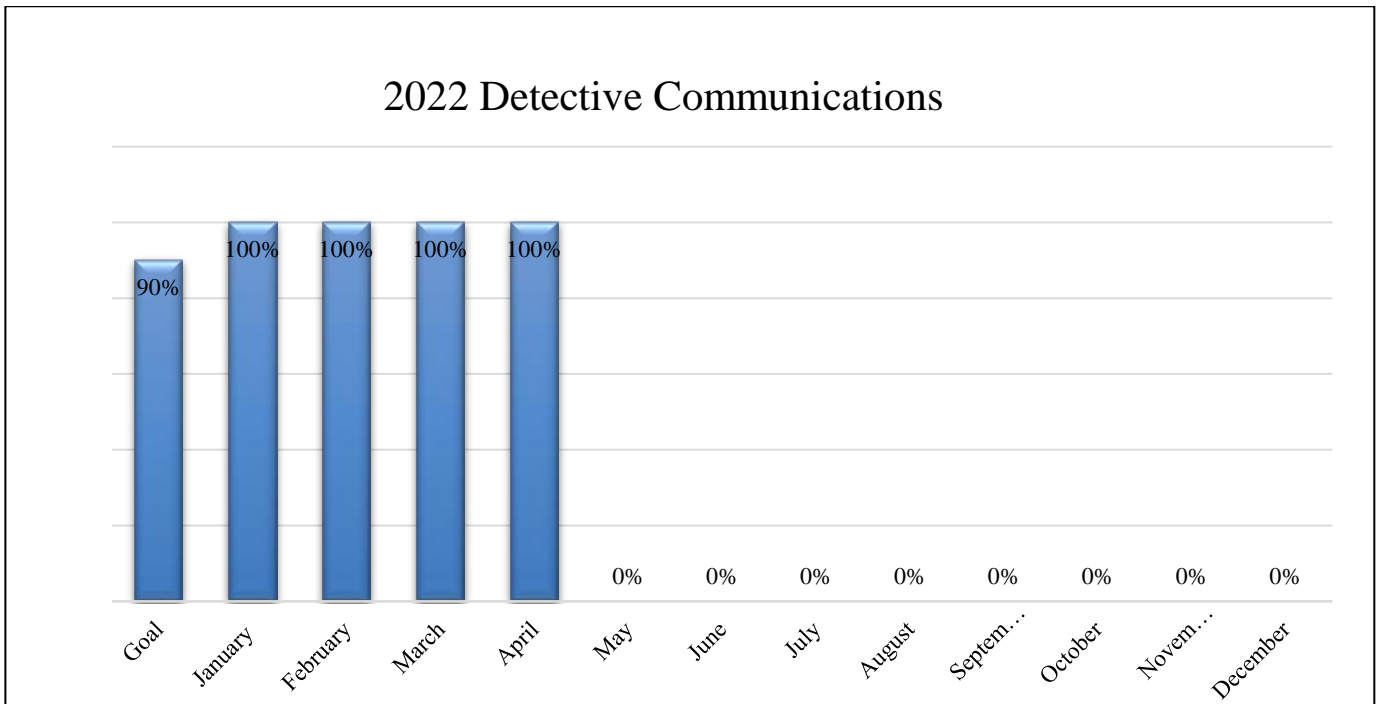
