### CRIME DATA

In May of 2022, there were seven Part 1 crimes: one burglary, five larcenies, and one motor vehicle theft.

Burglary: Unknown suspect(s) gained entry by prying open a bathroom window. Upon gaining entry, the suspect(s) ransacked the master bedroom/closet.

Larcenies: Unknown suspect(s) entered the victim’s vehicle and removed the victim’s wallet. The suspect(s) then used the victim’s credit card at the Ralph’s grocery store in Rancho Palos Verdes.

-Unknown suspect(s) entered the victim’s unlocked vehicle and removed property.

-Three suspects removed mail from victim’s mailbox and then fled in a vehicle. Officers responded to the scene and located the suspect vehicle. Three suspects were subsequently arrested.

-Unknown suspect(s) gained entry to the victim’s unlocked vehicle. The suspect(s) removed the victim’s passport and other personal documents.

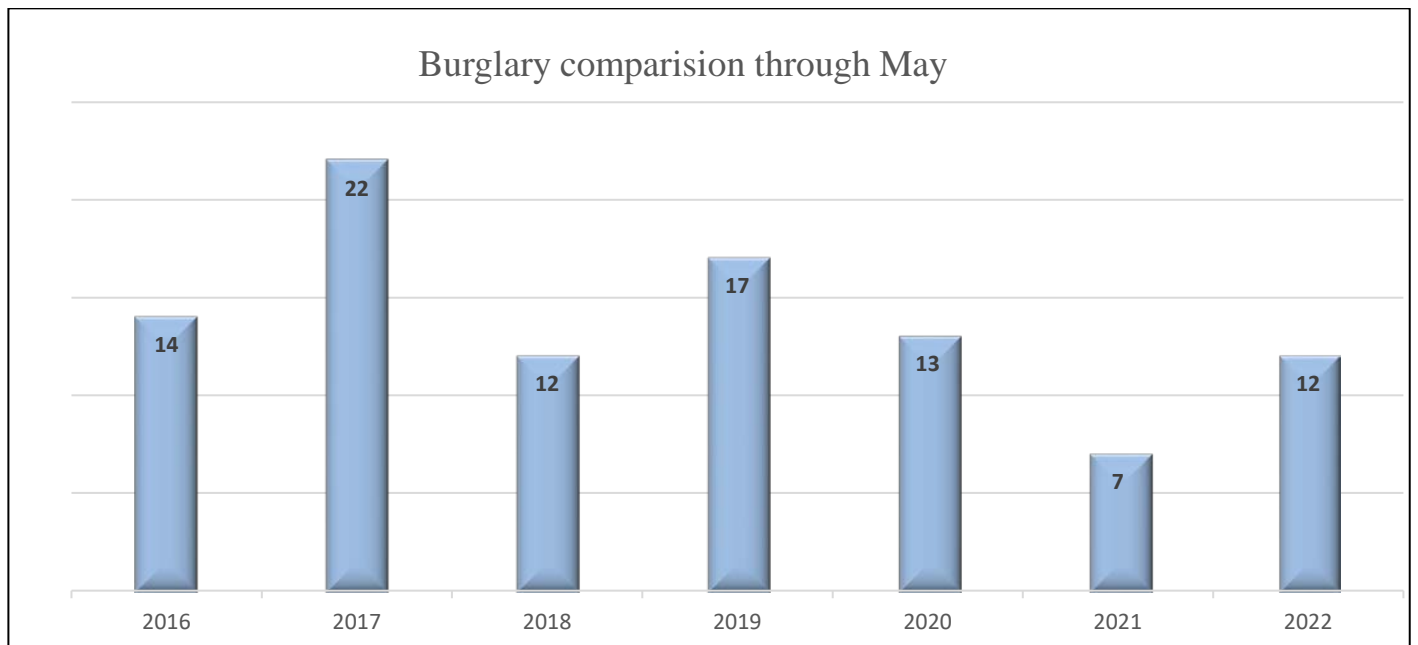
-Unknown suspect(s) removed the catalytic converter from the victim’s vehicle.

Motor Vehicle Theft: Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into the victim’s locked vehicle. The suspect(s) then took the vehicle and fled the scene. The vehicle was later recovered in Los Angeles by LAPD.

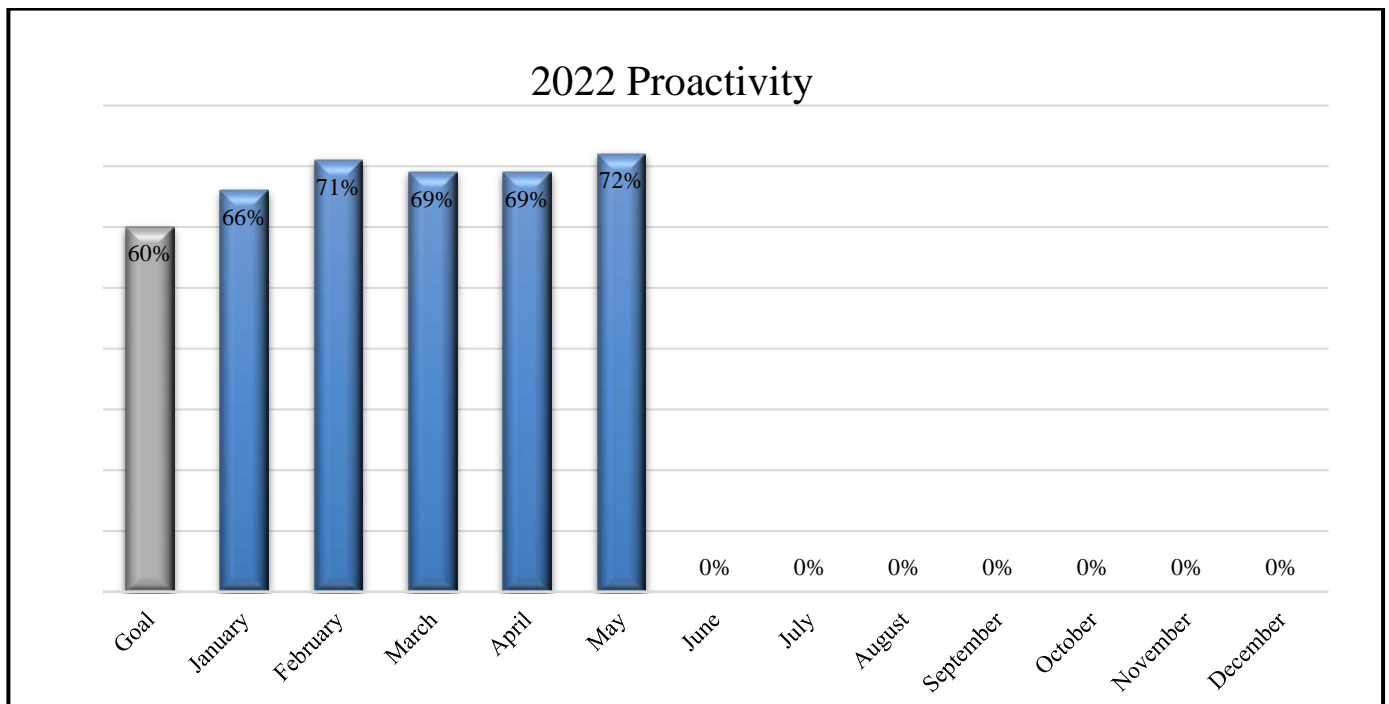

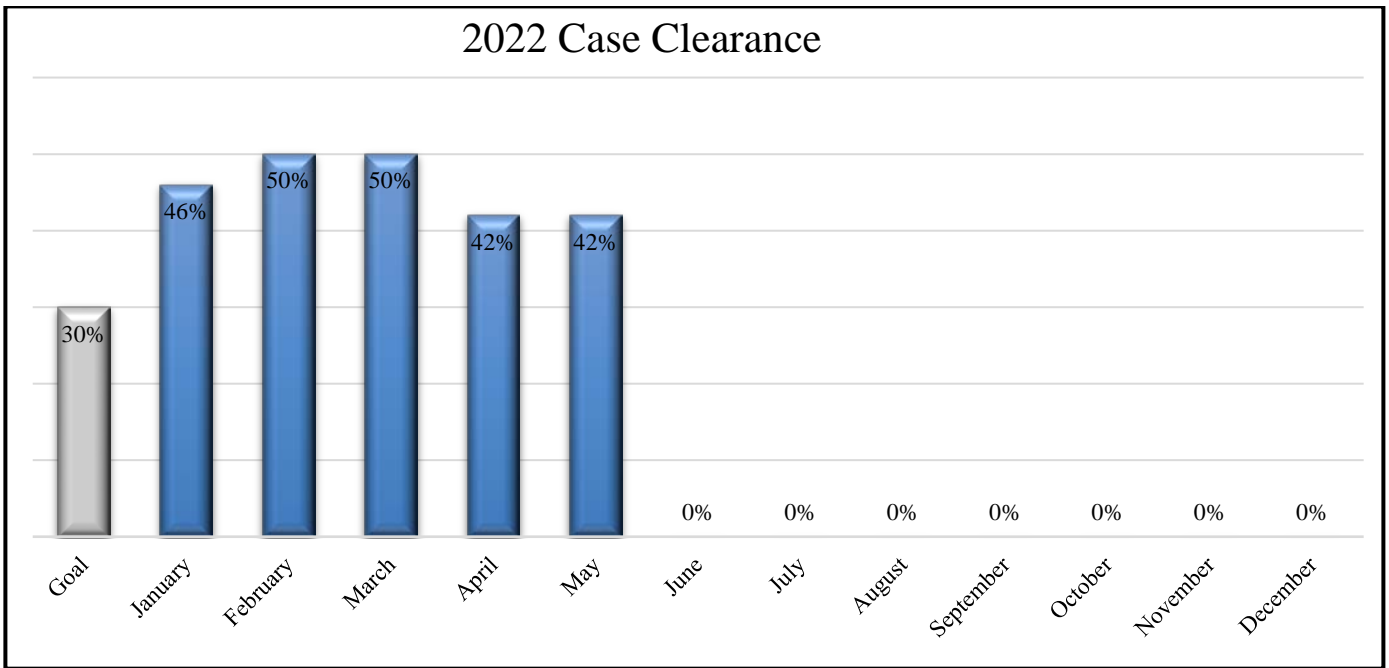

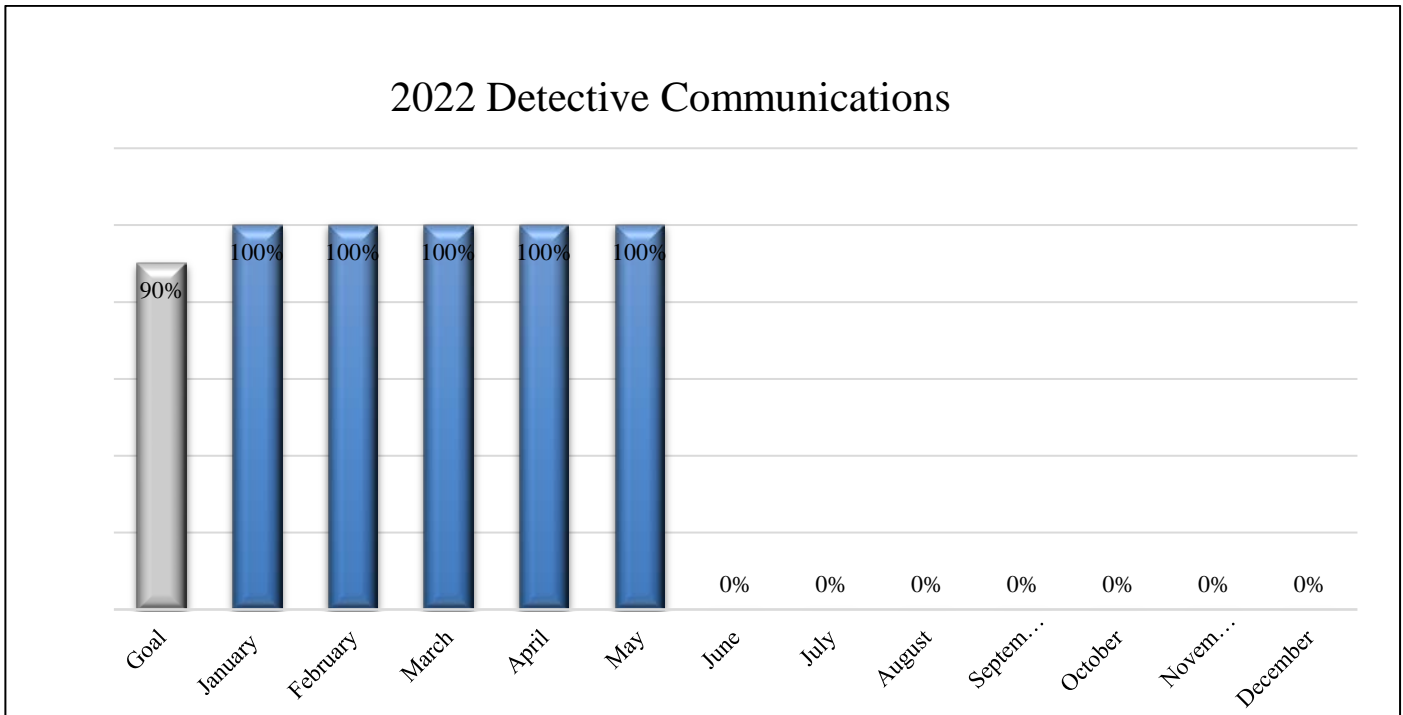
