#### **CRIME DATA**

In September of 2022, there were nine Part 1 crimes: 5 burglaries, and 4 larcenies.

<u>Burglaries</u>: Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into unoccupied residences through unlocked rear doors. Once inside, suspect(s) ransacked residences and fled with the victims' property.

Unknown suspect(s) gained entry to a residence by prying open a locked rear door. Once inside, the suspect(s) ransacked multiple rooms and fled the area in an unknown direction, undetected.

Unknown suspect(s) entered a fenced construction site and gained entry to an unsecure garage where appliances were being stored. Suspect(s) removed the appliances from their packaging and fled the area with the victim's property in an unknown direction, undetected.


Unknown suspect gained entry to a residence through an unsecure rear door / window. The suspect removed the victim's property and fled the area. Suspect returned a second time and removed additional property. PVEPD Detectives obtained video surveillance of the suspect, and later arrested the suspect for both burglaries. During the investigation, PVEPD Detectives recovered additional property linking the suspect to additional burglaries within the city. Additional burglary case filings are pending.

<u>Thefts from motor vehicle:</u> Unknown Suspect(s) gained entry into the victim's vehicle by unknown means. The suspect removed the victim's property and fled the area undetected.

Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into three unsecured vehicles. Suspect(s) removed property from victims' vehicles and fled the area with the victims' property undetected.




