#### **CRIME DATA**

In October of 2022, there were ten Part 1 crimes: 3 burglaries, 2 thefts of motor vehicles, and 5 larcenies.

### **Burglaries**:

-Unknown suspects entered an occupied residence through an unlocked rear door. Once inside, the suspects searched for items, however did not remove anything from the residence. The suspect then fled the residence on foot. PVEPD Officers obtained surveillance footage of the suspects from the victim and neighboring residences. PVEPD Detectives collaborated with another law enforcement agency, who ultimately arrested the suspects.

- -Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into a residence by smashing the window pane of a side door. Once inside, the suspect(s) ransacked rooms and removed the victim's property. The suspect(s) fled the area in an unknown direction, undetected.
- -Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into a residence by smashing the rear sliding glass door. Upon gaining entry, the suspect(s) ransacked rooms and removed the victim's property. The suspect(s) then fled the area in an unknown direction, undetected.

# Thefts of Motor Vehicles:

- -Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into the victim's unlocked vehicle. The suspect(s) then fled the area with the victim's vehicle, undetected.
- -Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into the victim's locked vehicle by unknown means. The suspect(s) then fled the area with the victim's vehicle, undetected.

#### Thefts from Motor Vehicles:

- -Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into four different vehicles within the same vicinity. In all four incidents, the suspect(s) removed property from the victims' vehicles and fled the area undetected.
- -Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into the victim's unlocked vehicle and removed property. The suspect(s) fled the area with the victim's property undetected.
- -Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into the victim's locked vehicle by unknown means and removed property. The suspect(s) fled the area, undetected.

# Theft of Motor Vehicle Parts:


-Unknown suspect(s) removed the catalytic converter from the victim's vehicle.

#### Theft of Mail:

-Unknown suspect(s) pulled their vehicle alongside the victim's mailbox located on the roadway's edge. The suspect(s) removed the victim's mail and fled the area.
