## **ARRESTS**

#### 08-24-2023 Arrest/Drugs

Malaga Cove Plaza

At approximately 3:26 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop. After contacting the occupants, and conducting a consensual search of the vehicle, officers arrested the passenger for Possession of a Controlled Substance.

#### 08-25-2023 Arrest/Outstanding Warrant

At approximately 9:02 AM, an officer responded to a report from an off duty officer who witnessed a vehicle running a red light. The officer was able to locate the vehicle described and conducted a traffic stop. After conducting a California Driver's License/Warrant inquiry, it was determined the driver had an Outstanding Warrant and was arrested for that warrant.
