ARRESTS

<u>03-21-2024 Impaired Driver</u>

2100 BLK PVDW

At approximately 12:16 AM, an officer observed a vehicle code violation and conducted a traffic stop. After observing an open container and learning the driver had a large hunting knife, the officer administered a test of the driver's horizontal gaze nystagmus and field sobriety test and placed the driver under arrest for Driving Under the Influence of alcohol.

03-21-2024 Impaired Driver

At approximately 11:19 PM, an officer observed a vehicle with window tint violation and lack of Turning Signals. As the officer contacted the driver, they could smell the strong order of an unknown alcoholic emitting from inside the vehicle. The officer administered field sobriety tests and based on the objective symptoms of intoxication was arrested for Driving Under the Influence.
