ARRESTS

04-06-2024 Impaired Driver

2700 BLK PVDN

At approximately 12:41 AM, an officer observed a vehicle traveling the wrong way on a one-way street and conducted a traffic stop. Detecting a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage, the officer conducted a DUI investigation and arrested the driver for Driving Under the Influence.

04-06-2024 Impaired Driver

At approximately 1:15 AM, an officer observed a vehicle driving without light and conducted a traffic stop. While speaking with the driver, the officer smelled a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage and conducted a series of Field Sobriety Tests and arrested the driver for Driving Under the Influence.

CRIMES NOT ON PREVIOUS REPORT

03-29-2024 Drugs/Incapacitated Driver

At approximately 5:25 PM, an officer responded to a report of a reckless driver and located a vehicle matching the description and ordered the vehicle to stop, however, the vehicle failed to stop, a violation of Stop Required and Disobeying Traffic Control Officer. Officers were able to conduct a traffic stop and asked the driver for any drugs in the vehicle. After receiving a white powdery substance from the driver, the officer conducted a vehicle search and located Psilocybin Mushrooms. The driver was issued a misdemeanor citation for Possession of Cocaine and Possession of Psilocybin Mushrooms.
