ARRESTS

04-19-2024 Warrant/Weapons Violation Arrest **400 BLK PVDW**

At approximately 12:33 AM, an officer noticed a vehicle driving without a front license plate and stopped it. Following a brief investigation and search of the vehicle, the officer arrested the passenger for carrying a loaded and unregistered handgun and a high-capacity magazine.

04-20-2024 Driving Under the Influence **3100 BLK PVDN**

At approximately 1:51 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop for moving violations. The officer conducted a DUI investigation and the driver was arrested for driving under the influence with a blood alcohol content of .08% or greater.

04-21-2024 Drugs, Burglary Tools, & Weapons **1600 BLK PASEO DEL MAR**

At approximately 3:23 AM, an officer contacted the occupants of a parked vehicle and developed probable cause to begin an investigation, including a vehicle search. The passenger was arrested for possession of a controlled substance, possession of burglary tools, possession of drug paraphernalia and convicted felon in possession of ammunition. The driver was arrested for possession of a controlled substance.

04-17-2024 Burglary **400 BLK VIA PVDW**

On 04-17-24, sometime between 11:30 AM and 2:27 PM, unknown suspect(s) used an unknown tool to smash the kitchen sliding glass window. Suspect(s) entered the residence, removed property, and fled the location with the victim's property undetected.

04-18-2024 Burglary **2900 BLK VIA VICTORIA**

Sometime between 04-16-24 at approximately 5:30 PM and 04-18-24 at approximately 6:30 AM, unknown suspect(s) smashed a side door glass window pane. Suspect(s) entered the residence, ransacked multiple rooms, and fled the location with the victim's property undetected.
