#### **ARRESTS**

## 08-08-2024 Traffic Offense

1100 BLK PALOS VERDES DR W

At approximately 8:35 PM, an officer conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle code violation and arrested the driver for driving without a license, possession of a controlled substance, possession of marijuana under 18 years of age, and possession of a switchblade knife.

### 08-09-2024 Impaired Driver

**300 BLK VIA ALMAR** 

At approximately 2:08 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for driving without headlights. The officer conducted a DUI investigation, and the driver was arrested for driving under the influence.

## 08-09-2024 Impaired Driver

**2500 BLK PALOS VERDES DRIVE W** 

At approximately 4:20 PM, an officer observed a vehicle failing to stop and no lighting equipment on license plate and conducted a traffic stop. The officer contacted the driver and smelling a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage, conducted Feld Sobriety Tests and arrested the driver for driving under the influence.

At approximately 3:45 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle violation and observed a large samurai sword on the rear passenger middle seat. After a verbal consent to search the vehicle, the officer arrested the driver for possession of methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia.

At approximately 5:02 PM, an officer observed a vehicle in violation of maintaining vehicle lighting and failing to obey traffic signs and conducted a traffic stop. Given consent to search the vehicle the officer located mail that was not in the name of the driver or passenger, burglary tools, drug paraphernalia. The driver was arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia, ID Theft and possession of burglary tools. The passenger was arrested for ID Theft, possession of methamphetamine, and conspiracy to commit a crime.

At approximately 5:02 AM, an officer conducted a traffic stop for vehicle code violations. A search of the vehicle revealed mail "fishing tools, burglary tools, stolen mail and narcotic paraphernalia. Both the driver and passenger were arrested.

While en-route, the officers observed a subject who matched the description and contacted him. The officer observed a large knife/machete and arrested them for Concealing a dirk/dagger and possession of drug paraphernalia.

At approximately 8:24 PM, officers were dispatched to a possible driver under the influence and identified the subject mentioned. Upon contacting the driver, an officer smelled a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from the driver and therefore attempted to conduct a standard field sobriety test and a preliminary alcohol screening device. The driver was subsequently arrested for driving under the influence. The breath test results showed a .338% BAC.

08-15-2024 Drugs MALAGA COVE PLAZA

At approximately 3:36 AM, an officer observed a vehicle with rear license plate light failing to be illuminated and conducted a traffic stop. The officer contacted the driver who could not provide a driver's license or vehicle documentation and was asked to exit the vehicle. After a search of the subject and vehicle, the driver was arrested for possession of Methamphetamine, possession of a controlled substance and possession of drug paraphernalia.

## 08-19-2024 Impaired Driver

At approximately 11:35 PM, an officer observed a vehicle with no driver side working front headlight and calibrated the speed of travel at 52 MPH in a 35 MPH zone and conducted a traffic stop. As the officer spoke to the driver they smelled a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage and conducted a series of standard field sobriety tests. The driver was unable to perform the tests and was placed under arrest for driving under the influence.
