ARRESTS

10-29-2024 Drugs 2100 BLK VIA OLIVERA

At approximately 10:55 AM, an officer observed a vehicle code violation and conducted a traffic stop and arrested the driver for driving without a license. With consent to search the vehicle, officers discovered a controlled substance. The charges of possession of a controlled substance and an outstanding warrant were then added.

10-31-2024 Impaired Driver

200 BLK PALOS VERDES DR W

At approximately 10:59 PM, an officer observed a vehicle code and driving violation and conducted a traffic stop. When contact was made with the driver, the officer conducted a series of standard field sobriety tests and arrested the driver for driving under the influence. Based on a blood alcohol content the charge of .08% or greater was added to the charges.
