Fire and paramedic funding in Palos Verdes Estates is determined by the voter approved formula that generates taxes equal to, and specifically for, the contract cost. Property owners in Rancho Palos Verdes, Rolling Hills and Rolling Hills Estates, in contrast, pay for the service based on the assessed value of their property according to the pre-Proposition 13 property tax allocation formula that cannot be changed; for these cities, there is no correlation between the amount assessed and the service. Of every dollar paid in property taxes in Rancho Palos Verdes, approximately \$0.18 is allocated to the LACoFD and \$0.06 is received by the City for municipal services for a total of \$0.24 for general and public safety services. In Palos Verdes Estates, \$0.11 of every dollar in property taxes received is for municipal services and public safety services, and the separate proceeds of the parcel tax are collected and directed for fire and paramedic services.

The following illustration demonstrates how the Proposition 13 assessment levy is applied in cities like Rancho Palos Verdes:

Using the same example above with the Palos Verdes Estates' tax formula, the Palos Verdes Estates property owner would pay a 20% lower levy, excluding LACoFD's perparcel special tax for a savings of \$191.32 (\$951.77-\$760.45) as illustrated by the following:

Cumulatively, property owners in Rancho Palos Verdes paid a total of \$20.2 million in fiscal year 2015/16 to the LACoFD for the two fire stations in comparison to \$4.7 million paid by property owners in Palos Verdes Estates for the one fire station.
